THE ACYS PROGRAM IS MANAGED BY REGIONAL MANAGER ACYS PETER DUNKLEY.







ACTIVE COMMUNITIES FOCUSES ON PROACTIVE, CONSISTENT YEAR-ROUND EARLY INTERVENTION ACTIVITIES FACILITATED AFTER SCHOOL HOURS AND DURING SCHOOL HOLIDAYS. ADDITIONALLY, WE FACILITATE MULTIPLE ANNUAL REGIONAL EVENTS, ENGAGE DIVERSE EXTERNAL PROVIDERS WHO ARE DOMAIN EXPERTS IN A RANGE OF YOUTH ENGAGEMENT DISCIPLINES, AND WE NOW RUN COMMUNITY LIBRARIES IN SEVERAL COMMUNITIES.

ACTIVE COMMUNITIES IS MANAGED BY ACTIVE COMMUNITIES MANAGER, DANIEL RULE.

YOUTH SERVICES FOCUSES ON MORE TARGETED SUPPORT FOR AT RISK YOUNG PEOPLE EXPERIENCING LOW TO MODERATE VULNERABILITIES. EARC ACCEPT REFERRALS, PROVIDE ASSESSMENT, AND TRIAGE YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER 3 SEPARATELY FUNDED BUT COMPLIMENTARY PROGRAM AREAS.

I HAVE WORKED IN THE RAMINGINING EARC LIBRARY FOR THREE YEARS.
PREVIOUSLY I WORKED AS A CLEANER. I LOVE WORKING HERE AND
WORKING WITH THE LITTLE ONES. MY GRANDDAUGHTER AND NEPHEW COME
TO SPEND TIME HERE AT THE LIBRARY READING AND DOING ACTIVITIES. WE
LIKE TO WATCH MOVIES TOGETHER. I ALSO LIKE TO DO READING, DRAWING
AND ART WITH THE KIDS.

IN THE LIBRARY WE HAVE BEEN FOCUSSED ON DOING REGULAR CLEANING TO MAKE THE SPACE WELCOMING FOR COMMUNITY MEMBERS. I'M PROUD THAT I HAVE SPENT TIME REARRANGING THE LIBRARY TO MAKE MORE ROOM FOR ACTIVITIES AND TO NEATLY PRESENT THE BOOKS AND SPACE FOR OUR COMMUNITY MEMBERS.

IN THIS ROLE I'VE IMPROVED MY COMPUTER SKILLS AND I'D LIKE TO DEVELOP THESE MORE IN THE FUTURE. I'D LIKE TO BECOME BETTER AT USING THE COMPUTERS SO I CAN GET THE TV AND COMPUTERS TO WORK AGAIN WHEN THEY HAVE AN ISSUE. THIS WILL HELP OUR PROGRAMS TO RUN WELL IN THE LIBRARY.

I AM DEAF. I RECEIVE HELP FROM OTHER ACYS STAFF TO INTEPRET WHEN NEEDED. I AM GRATEFUL FOR THIS SUPPORT AND AM ABLE TO DO MY JOB WELL AND TO A GOOD STANDARD.

THIS IS FULFILLING WORK. STRAIGHT AWAY AFTER SCHOOL KIDS COME HERE. WE ARE VERY BUSY EACH AFTERNOON.

THE LIBRARY IS IMPORTANT FOR RAMINGINING. IT PROVIDES A SAFE SPACE FOR PEOPLE TO COME TO. IT HELPS KIDS TO ENGAGE IN ACTIVITIES. ADULTS COME HERE TOO. ON THE HOT DAYS THEY LOVE TO COME IN THE AIRCON AND RELAX HERE AND READ BOOKS AND USE THE COMPUTERS.
