Tournament Entry Conditions

1. The tournament shall be conducted in accordance with ITF rules of tennis and the regulations adopted by Tennis NSW, Tennis Seniors NSW and Tennis Australia, except as altered by these conditions.
2. The committee shall have control of the tournament with the discretion to reject or grade players, combine/split or cancel events and run events under lights or on clay courts, hard courts or on external synthetic courts. The committee will try to run as many events as possible on synthetic grass or clay court surfaces, and will try to find a partner for any entrant on request.
3. Players are required to be financial members of a state tennis association. NSW players may do this by joining Tennis Seniors NSW for \$20/year at <http://www.tsnsw.com.au/membership>. Players who are not members of TSNSW must join TSNSW or pay a temporary membership fee of \$10. Players who have already paid one such fee this financial year may join for an additional \$10.
4. The tournament is open to players at least 30 years of age at 31/12/2026. A player turning 40 in 2026 may play in 30+ or 40+ age groups for singles, and so on. A pair of players turning 40 and 60 may play in 30+ or 40+ age groups for doubles or up to the 100+ age group for "combined doubles" (i.e., the ages are added). For enquiries, please contact the tournament director.
5. Each player must submit to the tournament director a separate entry form, which must be accompanied by full payment.
6. Players may compete in at most one event per time slot. Players are expected to check in at the venue 15 minutes early and may use the courts. A 5 minute warm up is permitted prior to the first match only.
7. All events will be in round robin format in pools of about 5 entrants. Players are expected to play the equivalent of four sets of tennis per event.
8. Winners will be determined on sets won, then games won, then games lost, then head to head. No refunds will be issued for withdrawals once the draw is complete. Winners for washed out or tied matches will be determined by the committee or by drawing lots. At least \$40 will be awarded to each winner and \$20 to each runner up.
9. Each player grants the right to make, use and show pictures of him/her during the event without compensation.
10. All players must wear appropriate footwear and attire.
11. Players must compete at their own risk. No claim for insurance due to injury will be accepted.
