Conditions of play

1. Play will commence at 9:30am, (after registration at 9:00am) on Saturday, June 6th.
2. Match times will be 9:30am – 12:30pm and 1:30pm – 4:30pm Sat & Sun and 9:30am – 12:30pm Mon.
Team Captains will be notified of their team's schedule, before the weekend, by email – so please advise an appropriate email address
3. The tournament will be played in a round robin format, and is for Tennis Seniors NSW players.
4. Entries will be restricted to a maximum of 18 teams, and will be graded according to the strength of the players, (not by age), by the organising committee. Each team may receive one BYE if less than 18 entries are received.
5. Each match will be played according to the number of teams participating. (***Maximum 5 minutes hit-up, included in playing time***). A bell will signify the end of play, where ***the point in play only is to be completed***.
6. Winning teams will be awarded 2 points for the match and a point for each set won. Losing teams will get one point for each set won. Teams will get half a point for any unfinished or unplayed set/s. **Captains of each team should enter the Match Result on the result card provided.**
7. Teams must have at least 2 Men and 2 Women.
8. Should anyone become injured during the course of a set, that set must be forfeited. A replacement may be used in any subsequent sets. This rule also covers using a replacement for a match or part thereof. (This player can be a registered team member, or another member of **equal or lesser standard** from another team.)
9. **The winning team shall be the one with the most points at the completion of all matches.** Where two teams have equal scores, the winner shall be determined by the result of the match in which the two teams played each other. Otherwise the winning team will be declared on a count-back – (average of sets won over sets played.)
10. The Committee reserves the right to determine the prize money.
11. All players must be current members of TSNSW or their equivalent state body.

*PLEASE NOTE Entries will close as soon as 18 team entries with fees are received.
