



Hammer grew up in a small Iowa town called, Eddyville. Living there gave him a unique perspective of community adhesiveness and giving back to others. He pays for any service member he


sees in eating establishments and generously donates time and money to many community entities.

I would like to represent 299 at the National Convention and will do my best to present any ideas and concerns that our Chapter may have. Thank you, Jerry Goodwin


#### Ron Roman


