- Must be 21 years of age or older to place and/or collect on a sports wager
- Three Rivers Casino Resort reserves the right to limit, accept, cancel and/or refuse any wager at any time
- Available sports for wagering are: football, baseball, basketball, boxing, MMA, hockey, soccer, golf and tennis
- Minimum and maximum wager amounts, odds and payouts on all sporting events will be determined
 by Three Rivers Casino Resort and are subject to change. Maximum payouts shall only be established
 through limiting the amount wagered and cannot be applied to reduce a winning wager amount
- The winner of an event will be determined on the date of the event's conclusion based on the official
 result published by the governing body for that event
- Dates and start times of events shown are for guidance purposes only, and may be changed by the officials of that event's league
- Wagers will be accepted up to the listed start time
- Management will keep records of all point spreads, odds, final scores and wagers to protect the guests and management in the case of obvious mechanical or human error
- All disputes will be resolved as set forth by the Tribal Gaming Commission of The Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians
- Three Rivers Casino Resort is not responsible for altered, unreadable, lost and/or stolen tickets
- Please check your wager for accuracy before submitting your wager or leaving the betting window or self-service terminal
- Future or outright wagers are considered action as long as a winner is officially announced, regardless
 of team relocation, team name change league affiliation, playoff format or season length within rules
 particular to a specific sport
- A prohibited sports betting participant is defined as any individual whose participation may undermine
 the integrity of the betting or the sports event, or any person who is prohibited for other good cause.
 These include:
 - Individuals under the age of 21
 - Individuals placing wagers as an agent or proxy
 - Individuals in a position of authority or influence over the participants in the sporting event
 - Members of sports governing bodies, associations or clubs which may grant them exclusive information regarding the outcome of an event
 - Individuals attempting to manipulate the odds/payout of an event through suspicious activity

THREE RIVERS Types of Wagers CASING RESORT

Straight Bet

- Money Line: Wagering on a team or player to win a game or event
- Point Spread: Wagering on the margin of victory of a game
- Total (Over/Under): Wagering on the amount of points both teams will combine to score in a game

Parlay

- A wager that specifies two (2) or more combined selections to win
- A tie, cancelled event or push in a three or more team parlay reduces the parlay to the next lowest betting bracket

Teaser

 A wager that specifies three (3) or more combined selections to win and or score according to the odds at the time the bet was made

Futures

Any wager that takes place in the future, usually involving choosing a team or individual to win
a certain league or event

Proposition (Prop) Bets

 A wager regarding an occurrence or non-occurrence of an event that is not tied directly to the final score or outcome of a game

In-Play (or Live) Wager

• A wager made on the outcome of an event after the event has started

A game or event is official:

- Baseball: after 5 innings or if the visiting team completes the top of the fifth inning and the home team is leading
- Football: after 55 minutes of play
- Basketball (College): after 35 minutes of play
- Basketball (Professional): after 43 minutes of play
- Boxing/MMA/UFC: when the bell is sounded signifying the start of the opening round
- Hockey: after 55 minutes of play
- Soccer: after 85 minutes of play
 - NOTE: WINNER DECLARED AFTER 90 MINUTES OF PLAY. SHOOTOUTS DO NOT COUNT TOWARDS WAGER RESULT
- Tennis: after one full set is completed
- Golf: Player must tee off in order to have action
