Engineering

- (Gary) The 1st Issue I 2021 Countywide Road Improvements is going out to bid tomorrow. Your Champion Avenue Issue I project, between State Rd. and Hoagland Blackstub Rd., will begin this year. You also have the 2021 Road Resurfacing Program which includes Copeland Avenue and Gertrude Ave. The permit has been obtained for the Champion #13 culvert replacement and this will be completed this year.
- (Randy) The bridges in Champion are in good shape.
- (Shawn) I'll send Dave Spay a list of roads to look at for possible Issue I projects.

Maintenance

- (Kenny) We will be replacing Champion #13 in house. We are also planning to chip seal Park Avenue. We wedge paved part of this road last year and will continue the wedge paving up to SR 88 and then chip seal all of it.
- (Shawn) I'm going to check with Tom for wedge paving on Prentice Ext., mill & fill on Angel Ct., and chip sealing on Shaffer.
- (Randy) I take it the salt dome came out okay?
- (Shawn) Yes, it came out really good.
- (Randy) Do you need anything?
- (Shawn) No, everything is good. You guys helped us out a lot.

Comments/Concerns:

- (Randy) You might want to place holders with the Commissioners for the water and sewer extensions. You could do a joint letter with Bristol reminding them about State Road and also an extension along SR 45. I think calling Frank would also be beneficial.
