

Peshastin Community Council  
Minutes of Regular Meeting October 9, 2019  
Peshastin Memorial Hall

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Patricia Ortiz at the request of Doug Clarke.

The minutes of meeting September 11, 2019 were read and approved with correction of spelling of Olivia Winters' name. Motion by Stan, second by Doug, unanimous vote in favor.

Treasurer's report: bank balance of \$1,101.32 with no outstanding bills

Old business:

CVCH Connect mobile clinic services: Stan made a preliminary review of the space at the side of Peshastin library, and reports there is likely enough space for parking the unit. Since the NCRL was quite positive about a partnership with CVCH, Tricia will talk with Alicia and the library board to see if they are in agreement and willing to sign a memorandum of understanding with CVCH.

New business:

Cheryl gave a preliminary report about planning for the Santa Breakfast which is to be held at the Memorial Hall Saturday December 7 from 8:30 to 10:00 am. Discussion was held regarding advertising, with suggestions for using fliers to the schools, P-D school reader board, posters to Dan's Market, Peshastin Post Office, Peshastin Library, Peshastin tavern, Saysa's Market, and the Peshastin and Leavenworth Facebook pages. Lauri is willing to post the flier on the Facebook pages. Further details will be decided at the November council meeting.

On behalf of the Cemetery District, Doug requests permission from the council to hang the old Peshastin road sign inside the Memorial Hall, as the council owns the sign. This was approved by unanimous vote.

Note was made of increased Chelan County Sheriff's deputy presence in town and along the North Road, to help curtail speeding. Council members are in agreement that this is a positive action.

Motion by Doug for adjournment; second by Cheryl, unanimous aye vote. The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
