Welcome Message

At Earth Sanctuary, every guest is valued. We are committed to ensuring that people of all abilities can experience the wonder of Central Australia, our eco-tours, and cultural programs. We recognise that accessibility needs vary, and our team takes great care to **reasonably tailor any aspect of the visitor experience** so that everyone feels included, supported, and respected.

1. Getting Here & Arrival

- Accessible Drop-Off Areas: Hardened surfaces are available for drop-off and pick-up.
- **Vehicle Support**: Guests with mobility needs may use Earth Sanctuary vehicles to access all areas of the site.
- **Advance Notice**: Our booking system allows you to let us know about your requirements, so we can prepare personalised support in advance.

2. Pathways & Site Access

- Hardened Accessible Paths: Traversable "beach mat" style pathways are installed in key areas to improve wheelchair access.
- **Assisted Vehicle Tours**: For guests who prefer not to traverse sandy paths, small vehicles provide access across the site.
- All-Terrain Wheelchair: An all-terrain wheelchair is available on request.

3. Buildings & Facilities

- Homestead Building: Portable ramps and staff assistance are available for entry.
- **Dining & Entertainment Area**: Open structures with firm matting for wheelchairs and mobility aids.
- **Amphitheatres**: Hardened seating areas allow wheelchair users to sit with family and friends.
- **Amenities**: Fully accessible unisex toilet located near the arrivals area. A new accessible shower facility is planned within 24 months.

4. Astronomy Experiences

- Modified Telescopes: For guests unable to access the rotating dome observatory, alternative telescopes are provided outside. Signage indicates their location.
- Seated Viewing Areas: Amphitheatre viewing areas have been adapted for mobility devices.

5. Camping & Outdoor Experiences

- Accessible Space Camp: At least one dome tent is adapted with hardened flooring for wheelchair positioning.
- **Swag Camping**: Alternative arrangements (such as vehicle-assisted setup) can be made for guests wishing to participate in sleeping under the stars.

6. Communication & Support

- Hearing Accessibility: Staff trained in clear communication; Auslan interpreters can be arranged with advance notice.
- Vision Support: Large-print materials and guided assistance are available.
 Staff are trained to provide clear verbal explanations.
- Personalised Assistance: Staff are trained to provide respectful, dignified assistance and to liaise with carers.

7. Commitment to Continuous Improvement

- Earth Sanctuary staff are trained in disability awareness and safe service delivery.
- Feedback is encouraged guest input helps shape our future accessibility improvements.
- We are committed to ongoing upgrades, including additional hardened pathways, accessible amenities, and digital accessibility in booking platforms.

- Allocate seating and vehicle access.
- Arrange interpreters or specialist equipment.
