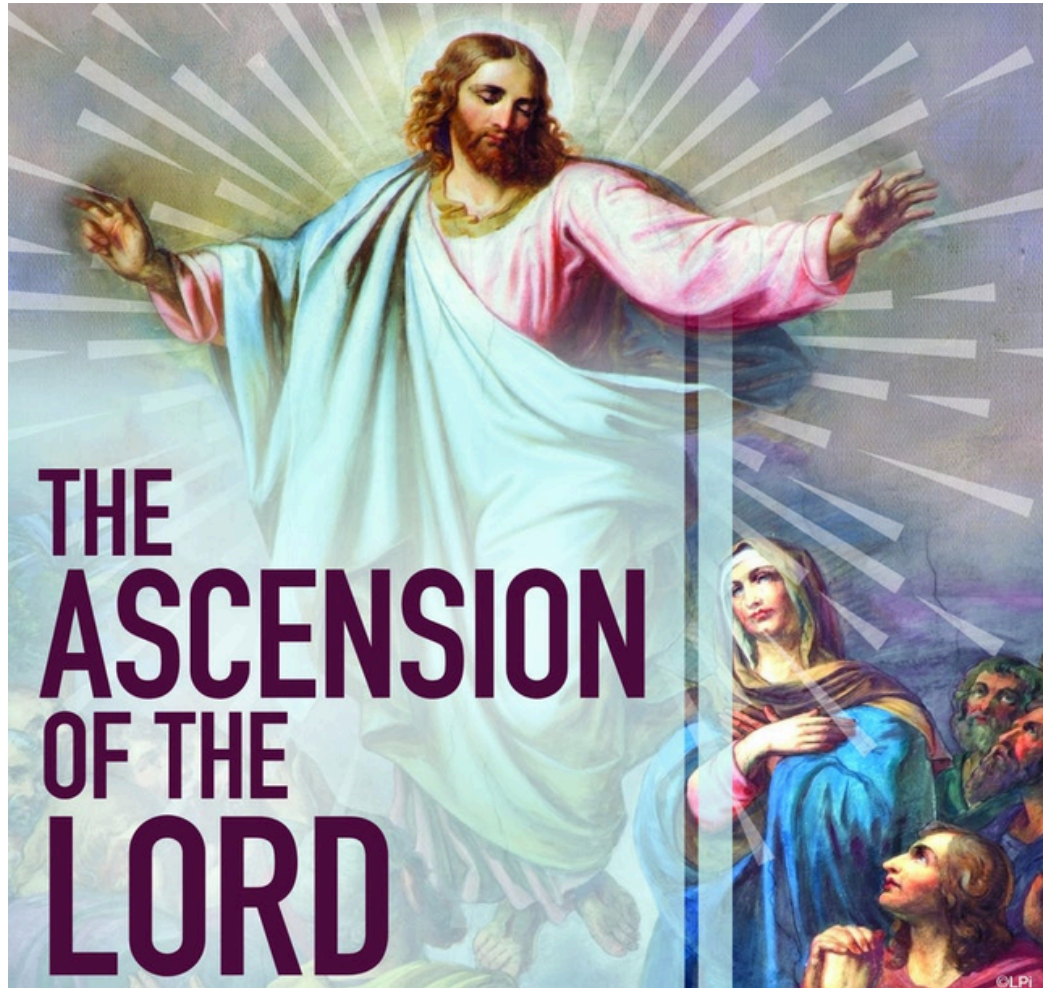

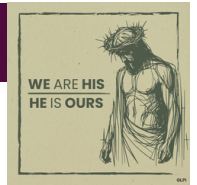


THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL FOCUS

May 17, 2026

7th Sunday of Easter

John 17:1-11a



Not long after my brother's first child was born, a beautiful little girl named Mary Elise, I asked him what it was like. Was he nervous? Overwhelmed? He said, "When I first held her, I was in such shock. I think I just said, 'I am your dad. I am your dad.'" That moment marked a deep transformation for him. He was not just holding a baby; he was stepping into a new identity. Over the years, I have seen him live his fatherhood with quiet sacrifice, joy, and faithfulness. It started with that moment of truth.

This, I propose, is a glimpse of what Jesus means when he prays, "Consecrate them in the truth." (John 17:17) To be consecrated is to be set apart in love, not taken out of the world. Consecration sends us into it with a new identity, always one that binds us to him and to others in love. Our bond to Jesus and others is the deep truth that he continually renews.

Whenever we speak deep truths about ourselves, we experience this renewal: "I have sinned;" "I need help;" "I forgive you;" "I take you as my husband;" "I believe in one God..." Whether in confession, in the liturgy, or in a recovery group, truth heals and transforms. And the deepest truth of all? That we belong to the Risen and Ascended Christ. Our lives are no longer just ours. We are his and he is ours.

Name one truth you need to step into more deeply, about yourself, someone else, or God. Maybe put it on a note on your mirror. Let that truth consecrate you this week.

LEARN ABOUT A PARTICULAR MARIAN APPARITION

It is important for us to always strive to better understand how Mary's intercession and the messaging of her apparitions help us to clearly see God's will for us and for the Church.

Each Sunday in May, the bulletin will feature a different Marian apparition.



Our Lady of Guadalupe is honored as a powerful symbol of faith, unity, and hope, especially among millions of people across the Americas. According to tradition, she appeared to Saint Juan Diego in 1531 on Tepeyac Hill in Mexico, speaking to him with tenderness and asking that a church be built in her honor. Her miraculous image, imprinted on Juan Diego's tilma, has become one of the most recognizable and beloved religious icons in the world. Many people see in her the loving presence of a mother who draws close to the poor, the vulnerable, and those seeking comfort. She is often celebrated as a bridge between cultures, blending Indigenous and Spanish elements in a way that reflects God's desire to reach every heart. Devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe continues to inspire acts of compassion, justice, and service.

Her feast day on December 12 brings together communities in prayer, music, and joyful celebration. Countless pilgrims visit her basilica in Mexico City each year, making it one of the most visited religious sites on earth. Her message of trust in God and care for one another remains as meaningful today as it was nearly five centuries ago. Many people turn to her in times of need, believing she intercedes with deep love. Her presence continues to remind the world that faith can transform lives and bring people together in hope.



Our very own Our Lady of Guadalupe shrine is a welcome place of personal prayer, reflection and often times celebration. Special thanks to Fr. Christopher, the Gardening Angels, Dr. Andrew, Carlos Lopez, Youth Group and many other volunteers that have recently helped renovate the area.

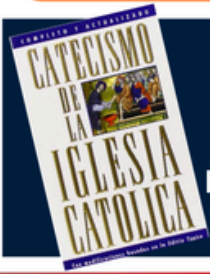
