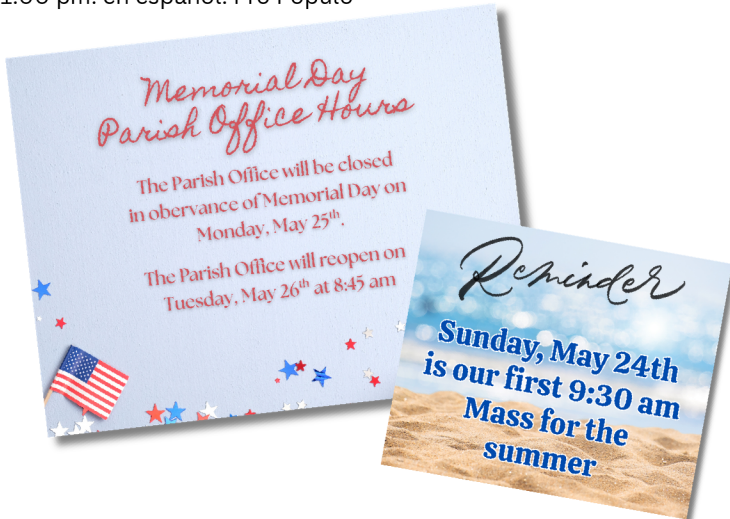

## THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL FOCUS



### May 24, 2026

### Pentecost Sunday John 20:19-23

“He breathed on them and said to them, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.’” (John 20:22-23)  
 For those of us who go to confession regularly, there is often a familiar frustration: “Why do I keep confessing the same sins?” It can feel like a loop, cleansed but unchanged. Pentecost reveals a hopeful perspective. When the Risen Jesus breathes on his ashamed and fearful disciples and gives them the Holy Spirit, he echoes Genesis, when God breathes life into Adam. This is not just primarily the removal of guilt, but new creation.

In confession, we receive more than forgiveness. We receive a fresh outpouring, the breath of the Spirit, and a renewed mission. Jesus does not say to us, “You’re forgiven, now go back to your old life.” He says, so to speak, “As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” (John 20:21)  
 That is why penance is not just saying a few prayers. It is reorientation. It is the Spirit summoning us to live differently: with mercy and healing.

Just as Adam was sent into the world, and the Apostles were sent out after Pentecost, so too we are sent from the confessional – not just clean, but consecrated.

**Pentecost Challenge:** After your next confession, ask the Holy Spirit for one way you can participate in Christ’s healing will for you. Then take one small, concrete step, and do not look back.

It is important for us to always strive to better understand how Mary's intercession and the messaging of her apparitions help us to clearly see God's will for us and for the Church.

*Each Sunday in May, the bulletin will feature a different Marian apparition or devotion site.*



Our Lady of La Leche in Florida is a cherished Catholic shrine known for its deep sense of peace and maternal devotion. Located in St. Augustine, it honors Mary nursing the infant Jesus, a rare and tender depiction that draws visitors seeking comfort and hope. The shrine traces its origins to the early 1600s, making it one of the oldest Marian devotion sites in the United States. Many people visit to pray for fertility, safe pregnancies, and healthy families, continuing a tradition that has lasted for centuries. The small chapel on the grounds feels intimate, inviting quiet reflection beneath its simple wooden beams. Surrounding oak trees and historic mission grounds add to the sense of sacred history. Pilgrims often leave written prayers or return to give thanks for blessings they believe were received through Mary's intercession. Today, Our Lady of La Leche remains a symbol of faith, resilience, and the enduring human longing for nurturing and protection.

This shrine is located approximately 3.5 hours from Hilton Head Island is an easy day trip or weekend trip. The shrine is also the start of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage that begins today, May 24th!

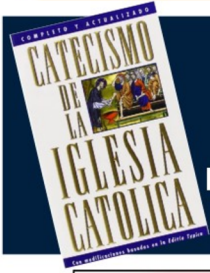
