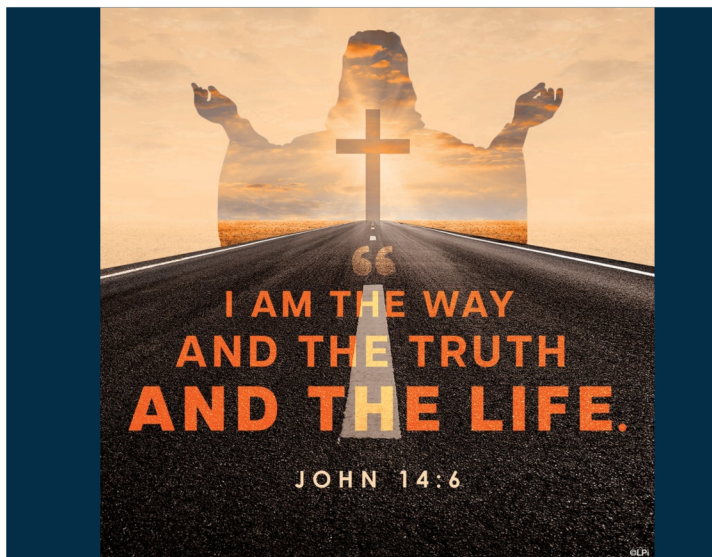

## THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL FOCUS



May 3, 2026

5th Sunday of Easter

John 14:1-12

We generally approach life with the question, "What can this do for me?" We try a new workout, a low-carb diet, intermittent fasting, or a new career path, hoping it will make us healthier, stronger, happier. The assumption is that if I invest in this, I'll eventually reap some benefit, or I won't do it. It is easy to think of faith the same way: if I really practice my faith, what will it do for me? Will it make me calmer, more moral, more successful?

But in today's Gospel, Jesus says something astonishing. He doesn't present himself as a teacher who shows us the way to life. He says, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life." (John 14:6) He is not merely a guide toward some higher benefit. He is the benefit itself. To know him is to know Life.

Thomas Aquinas explains that every desire in the human heart – love, joy, meaning, all of our restless cravings – is really an indirect cry for life. Even despair testifies to this longing: people despair precisely because they feel they are not, and might never be, fully alive.

The good news is that Jesus is not simply the means to a better life; He is Life itself. To believe in him is to share in God's own eternal vitality. Not simply later but even now. Faith is not a transaction that produces results – it is a union that fills us with joy. To be in communion with Christ is to be truly, fully alive.

LEARN ABOUT A PARTICULAR MARIAN APPARITION**

It is important for us to always strive to better understand how Mary's intercession and the messaging of her apparitions help us to clearly see God's will for us and for the Church.

*Each Sunday in May, the bulletin will feature a different Marian apparition.*



Bernadette Soubirous was a poor shepherd girl from the town of Lourdes, France who became known for a series of extraordinary visions in 1858. At just 14 years old, she reported seeing a beautiful lady in a grotto while gathering firewood.

The lady, later identified as Our Lady of Lourdes, appeared to Bernadette 18 times over several months. During these apparitions, the lady encouraged prayer, penance, and devotion to God. One of the most significant moments occurred when Bernadette was instructed to dig in the ground, revealing a spring of water. This spring, which continues to flow today, has been associated with many reported healings.

Initially, Bernadette faced skepticism and questioning from both civil authorities and Church officials. Despite this, she remained humble and consistent in her testimony. Eventually, the Catholic Church recognized the apparitions as authentic after careful investigation.

Bernadette later entered religious life and was eventually canonized as a saint, remembered for her simplicity, faith, and trust in God. Her feast day is April 16<sup>th</sup>.

Lourdes is nestled in the Pyrenees in southwestern France and has since become one of the most important pilgrimage sites in the world, drawing millions each year. The Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes is February 11<sup>th</sup>.

On the First Saturday during 5 consecutive months, the Devotion

consists of:

1. Going to Confession
2. Receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion
3. Praying five decades of the Rosary
4. Meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary

### SEVEN SORROWS OF MARY, EXPLAINED

The Seven Sorrows of Mary refer to seven key events in the lives of Jesus and Mary: the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the Child Jesus in Jerusalem, the meeting of Jesus and Mary as he carried his cross to Calvary, the Crucifixion and death of Jesus, the removal of the Body of Christ from the cross, and the burial of Jesus. These events illustrate the great suffering endured by Our Lord and his Blessed Mother, and remind Christians to unite our own sufferings with those of Jesus, following Mary's perfect example. Devotion to the sorrows of Mary dates to the early centuries of Christianity, with such proponents as St. Ephrem, St. Alphonsus Liguori and St. Bridget of Sweden. The Seven Sorrows devotion can take the form of seven Hail Marys, seven Rosaries or a novena, all recited while meditating upon the individual sorrows. ©LPI

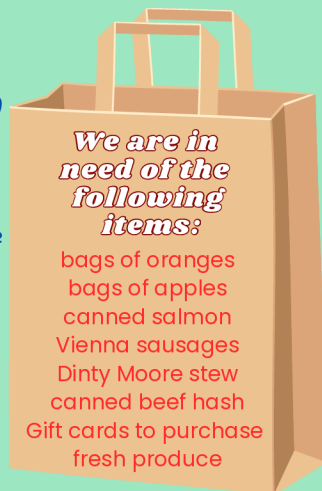

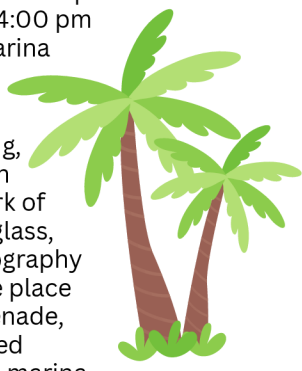
