

THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL FOCUS

August 17, 2025 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 12:49-53



During my baseball career, my best coach often said, "You shouldn't be worried if I yell at you. Be worried if I don't. If I stop pushing you, it means I don't think you have any more potential." He demanded a lot, and I knew it meant he saw that I could be something special on the baseball field. Jesus says some demanding words to us this week. "Do you think I have come to establish peace on the earth?" he asks, "No, tell you, but rather division" (Luke 12:51). He wants you and me-in fact, all the earth-to participate in the luminous glory of God. That's why he speaks of himself as a divine arsonist. Divine fire is like a good coach: it demands the removal of all that obstructs the achievement of the lofty goal.

How is your life demanding right now? That inconvenient family situation, the unfair boss at work, the kids who reject their parents' wishes, the nagging health issue? Maybe things would be more peaceful devoid of these seemingly arbitrary difficulties. But for us who believe in the one who comes to set the earth of fire, we should be much more worried if he stops demanding so much from us. In fact, let's thank him for it. He sees how glorious we can become.

QUESTION:

Why do we have a feast for the Queenship of Mary?

Answer:

For many of us, the language of kings and queens may seem like they belong to history or a medieval movie. Royalty have absolute authority over a kingdom and their subjects, a concept that is foreign to many of us today. While Jesus doesn't rule a political kingdom, we honor and recognize him as the King of Kings, Lord of Heaven and Earth. To God alone belongs absolute authority over all of existence.

We may think of queens as the spouse of the king, but there is another key relationship: the king's mother. In Biblical history, we see instances where the mother of the king is given due as a queen herself, complete with a throne! Mary's guiding influence over her Son is seen most notably in the Wedding Feast at Cana. Mary is not Queen on her own merit. She is "full of grace" and "blessed" in "all ages" because of the reign of her Son.


Retrouvaille Marriage Help offers a welcoming and loving space to couples who have been living with the misery of a failing marriage.







Enfoque del Evangelio

XX Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

La forma como nos llevamos a veces en la familia y con los amigos es dolorosa: pleitos, venganzas, argumentos sin sentido, tan solo para herirnos. Alegamos por política, por deporte, por religión y más. Nos encendemos de la nada; pareciera que traemos fuego para discutir. Perdemos el control de la nada y por nada. Pero el fuego del que Jesús nos habla hoy es diferente. Es el fuego de la justicia, del perdón y de la inclusión: "He venido a traer fuego a la tierra, y ¡cuánto desearía que ya estuviera ardiendo!" (Lucas 12:49). Compartir esa pasión por Jesús es algo que muy pocos entienden. Se trata del fuego del Espíritu Santo en nosotros.

De nuevo se nos repite la misión de Jesús al mundo: "Traer a la tierra el fuego que enciende la vida y mediante el cual el hombre es salvado. Jesús nos llama a difundir en el mundo este fuego, gracias al cual seremos reconocidos como sus verdaderos discípulos" (Papa Francisco). San Juan Crisóstomo (c. 350-407) decía que: "Esto es el fuego del Espíritu Santo: él no tolera que se tenga algún deseo mundano; en cuanto, nos conduce a otro tipo de amor... De hecho, cuando la fuerza de este fuego ha entrado en el alma del hombre, éste expulsa la indiferencia y la pereza". Dejarnos conducir por el Espíritu Santo es el secreto que nos dispone a dar la cara por la justicia y la paz. De esas divisiones habla Jesús, referente a estar en contra unos de otros en la familia y los amigos. Es que vivir el Evangelio y ser testigos de él dando testimonio divide.


