Orange Grove Center was established in 1953 by parents of children with intellectual disabilities to provide educational opportunities and needed supports across the lifespan. The center offers a full array of services, including education, vocational opportunities, residential options, therapy and health care services, recreation, counseling and a robust research portfolio with university affiliations.

Orange Grove Center staffs six local recycling convenience centers as well as three refuse collection centers through a partnership with the City of Chattanooga. Our Document Destruction "Better Shred than Read" program serves a total of 303 customers encompassing the areas of Chattanooga, Knoxville, Nashville, North Georgia and Muscle Shoals, Alabama. Our Document Destruction program provides employment for 15 individuals with disabilities.
