**TENNESSEE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES HONORS JAYME SALISBURY FOR
SPECIAL OLYMPICS GOLD MEDAL WINS**

Chattanooga, TN – Orange Grove Center is proud to host a special presentation honoring Special Olympics gold medalist Jayme Salisbury on Friday, April 4, at 1:30 PM. Salisbury will be honored by members of the Tennessee legislator with the Tennessee House Joint Resolution No. 208 in celebration of his outstanding achievements in the 2025 Tennessee Special Olympics Winter Games.

Competing in Gatlinburg, Tennessee, from January 26-28, Salisbury secured two gold medals in the snowboard slalom and snowboard giant slalom events. Remarkably, Salisbury had only ever practiced once, just the day before the competition. The Resolution No. 208 commends his dedication, determination, work ethic, and talent, which were on full display during the competition.
