Standard Services and Equipment Prices

The standard services & equipment prices represent the minimum & non-declinable elements required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person. These prices are applicable to every client family we serve, no matter what additional services or options are part of the final arrangements. The standard service charge includes:

Professional fees ————— \$150*

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including, but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs. Coordination & implementation of basic arrangements including activities and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers.

Documentation – permits, forms, etc — \$130*

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, Coroner's certificate for cremation. Provision of 10 Proof of Death forms issued by Affordable Burials and Cremations, these forms can be used for estate settlement purposes.

Transport remains ————— \$220* – initial or additional (within 30km)

Transportation of the deceased from place of death to our facility and to the place of disposition. For cremations, includes return of cremated remains to our facility. A charge applies for each additional transportation request.

Administrative Vehicle ————— \$135*

Vehicle used to complete death registration and other administrative requirements.

Facilities ————— \$130*

Our office location where administrative services and client communications are handled.

Preparation of remains

Dressing ————— \$200

Pacemaker removal ————— \$125

Setting Features ————— \$150

Bathing, Dressing & setting features ————— \$450

Additional mileage per kilometer ————— \$2.50

mileage travelled beyond 30 km from the business will be charged one way only

Two person removal ————— \$150

Added to transport remains fee when removal is from a nursing home, coroner's office, residence or when the body exceeds 200lbs.

After hours removal ————— \$150

Added to transport remains fee when the removal is completed outside our regular business hours of 8am to 6pm.

Additional Proof of Death after one year \$100

Additional Proof of Death forms are no charge for the first year.

Infectious disease handling ————— \$350

(Including but not limited to: COVID-19, Hepatitis, MRSA, HIV, SARS)

This fee includes extra: Gloves, Masks, Gowns, Eye Protection, and disinfection processes to ensure the safe handling of the remains, cleansing of facilities, vehicles, and equipment.

Body storage after 48 hrs ————— \$100 per day

Additional Transportation of Urn within 30km \$150

Shipping cremated remains within Canada — \$250

Includes packaging, paperwork, postage and tracking.

Staff services for obtaining certified copies of the death certificate ————— \$250

Includes procurement. Government fees not included.

Transferring cremated remains between vessels ————— \$75

Storage of cremated remains — \$30 per month

Cremated remains may be stored at our facility for up to one year. A credit card is required and billed monthly.

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains \$350

Unclaimed cremated remains may require a deposit. If not claimed within one year, the deposit may be used to inter them in common ground. The deposit is refunded if claimed within that period.

This price list has been filed with the Bereavement Authority of Ontario and is subject to change. Unless otherwise specified, applicable taxes are in addition to the prices listed.

Casket burial	\$600
Includes licensed and non licensed staff and vehicles for the day of the burial. Our staff will place the casket on the grave at the specified time and leave, cemetery staff will ensure the casket is buried.	
Coordinating activities	\$375
Includes contacting facilities to confirm details such as timing, location, and procedures. Applied when coordinating identification, cemetery interment, or memorial services without the presence of human remains. We do not arrange, coordinate, conduct, or participate in visitations, funerals, or services where human remains (including cremated remains) are present.	
Coordination of Scheduled Cremation (No Witnessing)	\$150
This service does not include witnessing. The cremation will take place without family present. Families may be on cemetery grounds if they wish, however they are not permitted inside the crematorium building during the cremation process. In rare circumstances beyond our control, the scheduled time may require adjustment.	
Staff for Identification Beyond 15 Minutes	\$600
Over time	\$150
This fee applies any time a service goes beyond the allotted 3-hour time limit. It is a per hour charge for each staff and vehicle.	
Weekend Fee	\$300
This fee applies when a burial, identification or service is requested for a weekend.	
Rush Cremation	\$250
Cremated Remains ready within 72 hours of having a signed contract and release from place of death.	
Use of Funeral Coach (3 Hours)	\$600

Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Cremation Fee - This fee is charged every time a cremation is requested and will depend on the crematorium selected and their current prices.

Payment, financing, and funding

Payment is due immediately upon signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards.

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

Funding: we offer the option of prepaying for services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today, and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered, or the contract is cancelled.

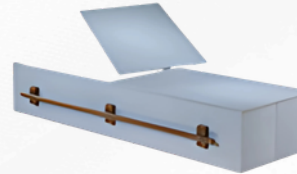

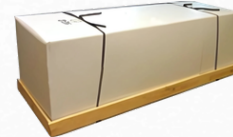
