Dear Parish Family,

We begin the third week of Lent this Sunday. This week offers us an opportunity to "be still and trust in his love, trusting in that love to not be afraid." This is our Lenten theme. Listening to the Voice of Love

"O that my people would listen to me, that Israel would walk in my ways!" (Psalm 81:13)

Prayer is the discipline of listening to the voice of love. Jesus spent many nights in prayer listening to the voice that had spoken to him at the Jordan River. We too must pray. Without prayer, we become deaf to the voice of love and become confused by the many competing voices asking for our attention. How difficult this is! When we sit down for half an hour—without talking to someone, listening to our music, watching television or reading a book—and try to become very still, we often find ourselves so overwhelmed by our noisy inner voices that we can hardly wait to get busy and distracted again. Our inner life often looks like a banana tree full of jumping monkeys! But when we decide not to run away and stay focused, these monkeys may gradually go away because of lack of attention, and the soft gentle voice calling us the beloved may gradually make itself heard.

Let us pray for one another in a particular way during these special days in our parish life.


