

St. Bernadette Church March 17, 2024

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I hope you have had a blessed Lent up to this point! For me, Lent this year has been a bit of a roller coaster. There have been moments of great consolation and there have been moments where I would rather just give up and ditch all of my Lenten practices. Through it all, I find that the Lord continues to be faithful to me, even when I don't do my best in being faithful to Him. I pray that the same is true for you!

As we find ourselves about two weeks out from our celebration of Easter, I wanted to offer a few invitations:

- 1. If you have never had the opportunity to attend the celebrations of the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil), I would invite you to consider doing so this year. I know that our Music Director, Brook, has some really amazing plans for the celebration of these liturgies. Additionally, we are going to have the opportunity to welcome a number of new members into our parish through RCIA, so it would be awesome to show them support by attending these celebrations. As we have reflected on the theme, "Be Still and Trust in My Love," these liturgies are a great opportunity to do just that!
- 2. On March 28th, Holy Thursday night, there is a tradition to visit 7 Altars of Repose. At the end of the Holy Thursday Liturgy, the Eucharist is removed from the tabernacle and placed in a different location to commemorate the time after the Last Supper when Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane for the Agony in the Garden. The practice of visiting the 7 Altars is a tradition that was started in Rome in an effort to comfort and console the Heart of Jesus in His agony before His crucifixion. This year, we have organized a 7 Altar pilgrimage immediately following the 7 PM Holy Thursday Liturgy. See the next page for more information.
- 3. On Good Friday, March 29 at 7 PM, we will have a showing of the film, "The Passion of the Christ" in our Church. This will be an opportunity for us to gather as a parish community to view the film and pray with it together. The film is rated R for graphic violence, so this is probably not an activity for children.

Divine Mercy Sunday

What is Divine Mercy? Divine Mercy is the love of God in the midst of our brokenness and sin, freely given to us, and it is up to us to accept it and trust in God.

What is Divine Mercy Sunday? Divine Mercy Sunday is the first Sunday after Easter. It is a day to celebrate and accept the infinite mercy and love that Jesus gives to each of us! Jesus told St. Faustina "On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy" (Diary of St. Faustina, no. 699).

How to prepare for Divine Mercy Sunday? By going to Confession in the days leading up to this day (may be during Lent) and receiving Holy Communion on this Feast Day, Jesus will grant the grace of "complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary, no. 699). Jesus told St. Faustina: "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (Diary, no. 1109).

What about the Chaplet of Divine Mercy? The Chaplet of Divine Mercy was given by God to St. Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s. Although it can be prayed at any time, Jesus revealed to St. Faustina His desire for a Novena of this Chaplet to be prayed in the nine days leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday, starting on Good Friday. Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet also helps us to prepare to receive the graces of this day.

Join us on Sunday, April 7th at 3:00pm to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy as a community along with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament!


