

Divine Mercy Sunday

What is Divine Mercy? Divine Mercy is the love of God in the midst of our brokenness and sin, freely given to us, and it is up to us to accept it and trust in God.

What is Divine Mercy Sunday? Divine Mercy Sunday is the first Sunday after Easter. It is a day to celebrate and accept the infinite mercy and love that Jesus gives to each of us! Jesus told St. Faustina "On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy" (Diary of St. Faustina, no. 699).

How to prepare for Divine Mercy Sunday? By going to Confession in the days leading up to this day (may be during Lent) and receiving Holy Communion on this Feast Day, Jesus will grant the grace of "complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary, no. 699). Jesus told St. Faustina: "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (Diary, no. 1109).

What about the Chaplet of Divine Mercy? The Chaplet of Divine Mercy was given by God to St. Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s. Although it can be praved at any time, Jesus revealed to St. Faustina His desire for a Novena of this Chaplet to be prayed in the nine days leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday, starting on Good Friday. Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet also helps us to prepare to receive the graces of this day.

Join us on Sunday, April 7th at 3:00pm to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy as a community along with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament!

More information and how to pray the Chaplet is available in the back of the Church.




Thank you to everyone who donated to Coats for Needy Folks! We collected a large amount of coats for the homeless in our area. We are no longer accepting donations. Thank you again!

Dear St. Bernadette Community,

Our school community held an amazing event on March 15th to benefit the St. Baldrick's Foundation in their fight against childhood cancer. So many selfless individuals stepped up to unite as one to shave in solidarity for children with cancer or donate their hair for those who have lost their own... students, parents, boys, women, men, and three young girls alike. So many others along with them raised funds to support the cause. Our goal was \$70,000. As of the printing of this bulletin, we are at \$96,000 and counting! Why is this important? Well, the St. Baldrick's Foundation tells us that \$50,000 provides one infrastructure grant for a year for childhood cancer research and each \$10,000 allows 10 children to be treated in a clinical trial. This is unbelievable! Students, parents, faculty, parishioners, and our priests all joined together to pull off something truly wonderful. The parish community also helped us in our quest to raise over \$10,000 for Fr. Joe, and, as you can see, we succeeded. Fr. Joe went through with his promise to get his head shaved and we are grateful for his huge support of our cause.

Thanks to all of you who not only helped us reach our goal but exceed it. We are truly grateful for all your support, donations, and prayers. We are ecstatic that, together, the parish and school communities have been able to touch so many lives!
