

St. Bernadette Church April 7, 2024

Dear Parish Family,

"This Sunday we begin to reflect on the crowning truth of our faith in Jesus Christ. It is a truth documented by the New Testament, and was a matter of supreme importance in the faith and life of the first Christian communities. It was transmitted by tradition as a fundamental element of the faith; never was it neglected by true Christians...It is, in short, the truth of Christ's Resurrection. The Apostles' Creed tells us: "The third day he rose again from the dead," and the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed adds: "On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures." It is a dogma of the Christian faith, based upon a fact that historically took place and was verified. We shall seek to investigate "with minds bowed down," the mystery expressed by the dogma and contained in the fact, by beginning with an examination of the biblical texts which attest it."

"The oldest written testimony to Christ's resurrection is in the *First Letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians* (about Easter, A.D. 57). Paul writes: "*I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received,* that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. Then he appeared to James, and then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me" (I Cor 15:3-8)."

"As obvious, the Apostle speaks here of the living tradition of the resurrection, which had come to his knowledge after his conversion on the road to Damascus (cf. Acts 9:3-18). When he went to Jerusalem he met the Apostle Peter and also James, as is stated in the *Letter to the Galatians* (1:18 f.), and he now mentions them as the two principal witnesses of the risen Christ."

Tomorrow we are reminded that to look directly at the eclipse, it is imperative to wear protective glasses. To experience the Resurrection of Jesus, we could not witness the resurrection event. But what we do gaze upon is a tomb that is empty. What we do experience is the effect that Easter had upon the lives of those early witnesses. Fearful Peter and fleeing Apostles boldly exclaimed that He is risen. The experience of Jesus risen from the dead changed their lives. It is that witness that Paul confirmed in his writings. During these days of the Easter season, may our lives of faith continue to grow. Be not afraid of questions or not understanding completely what it means that Jesus rose from the dead. But in faith take a risk of living life boldly and with meaning knowing that God in Christ has conquered all sin and yes death itself.

Divine Mercy Sunday

What is Divine Mercy? Divine Mercy is the love of God in the midst of our brokenness and sin, freely given to us, and it is up to us to accept it and trust in God.

What is Divine Mercy Sunday? Divine Mercy Sunday is the first Sunday after Easter. It is a day to celebrate and accept the infinite mercy and love that Jesus gives to each of us! Jesus told St. Faustina "On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy" (Diary of St. Faustina, no. 699).

How to prepare for Divine Mercy Sunday? By going to Confession in the days leading up to this day (may be during Lent) and receiving Holy Communion on this Feast Day, Jesus will grant the grace of "complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary, no. 699). Jesus told St. Faustina: "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (Diary, no. 1109).

What about the Chaplet of Divine Mercy? The Chaplet of Divine Mercy was given by God to St. Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s. Although it can be prayed at any time, Jesus revealed to St. Faustina His desire for a Novena of this Chaplet to be prayed in the nine days leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday, starting on Good Friday. Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet also helps us to prepare to receive the graces of this day.

Join us on Sunday, April 7th at 3:00pm to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy as a community along with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament!




