Last week's bulletin included the Financial Year End 2023 statement of our parish. This week I would like to present to you the Capital Assessment of our parish buildings and grounds. The Diocese of Cleveland chose St. Bernadette to be a pilot project in their assessment of all diocesan facilities. In the past thirteen years, we have continually made improvements and upgraded our facilities. I am pleased to report to you that the Diocesan Assessment that was conducted by an impartial organization, found us to be in a most favorable position. Thank you for your past support and we are dependent upon your continued support as we move towards celebrating our 75th Anniversary as a parish.

The Facility Survey and Capital Plan summarized the results of the facility assessment recently performed at the parish. Through diligent efforts of renovation and restoration, our property scored highly. With the generosity of so many parishioners, we have been able to maintain our property well. A few systems of the school and the church are aging and will need to be addressed shortly. The Diocese review focused on concrete work and fire prevention/safety work, both of which we will address within the next months. There are always projects that present themselves. Again, thank you for your donations to the Offertory Collection, Faith Direct, the Pious Trust, and the Perpetual Endowed Trust, which allow us to maintain our campus.



them.




