

St. Bernadette Church August 31, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As Fathers Racco and Menkhaus mentioned last week from their chair, a new Choir season will soon be upon us! I first want to take this opportunity to thank everyone from our parish who has had the courage to step forward and offer their gift of music to our parish. Their talents combined with their dedication and hard work glorifies God and brings honor to our parish liturgies. In the light of this new season, we humbly ask that you please keep us in your prayers. The prayers of all of you, our parish family whom we serve, is the greatest support for all of us as we grow as parish musicians to better serve you. When we gather to prepare for our liturgies, be assured of your liturgical choir's prayers for all of you as we strive to humble and offer ourselves to be instruments through which God may speak to our hearts.

As God wishes to speak in all of us, I invite you to reflect on your own gift of song that dwells in your heart. What do you hear? Is it "Peace train" by Cat Stevens? Is it Lady Gaga? Is it "Stairway to Heaven" by Led Zeplin? Is it Beethoven? Whatever it may be, even if secular and not sacred, let it be a reminder that, as our source and origin is in the redeeming God, so too is the gift of his song within in us where music is born. This is why it is fitting for us to use the gift of song when we gather as a parish family, that it may lead us to the realm of higher things. By its very nature, song has both an individual and communal dimension. But unless the cry of music from deep within us sounds, it does not become music. When the cry from deep within us does become music, it is accessible to others.

While it remains a privilege and honor to offer our gift of song for the greater glory of God, we know, as the Choir, that the greater voice of the gathered assembly is the primary voice of our Church. It is our duty, our ministry, to enable and support our parish family to have the courage to always lift up their voices in song as the scriptures so profoundly command us. Knowing full well how vulnerable of a feeling singing in public can be for anyone, we pray our ministry in this new season may serve as a reminder that your gift of song is a powerful gift from Almighty God. You have been called by God to praise His Name. You have a right to praise Him, and he delights in your gift of song you offer back to Him. If we have the courage to sing in the midst of the assembly, we are sure to truly experience, in greater ways, the presence of God in our midst.

It has been and continues to be the joy of my life to be your organist, and I remain, your servant in Christ,
