On Saturday, October 4th at the 4:00PM Mass and Sunday, October 5th at the 11:30AM Mass, St. Bernadette Parish will celebrate the Mass of Anointing for those who have an illness or those who are elderly and would like to receive the Sacrament of Healing. There is no need to wait until a person is close to death. We welcome everyone regardless of age, who feels the need for physical or emotional healing and the Peace of the Lord.

What: A Liturgy of the Word geared for young children



presenting the Sunday readings and reflections on their level

When: Each Sunday at the 9:45am Mass.

Where: Father invites the children to the altar prior to the first reading. From there we proceed to the Community Room in the back of the church. After the Prayers of the Faithful, the children are welcomed back to join the rest of the community for the celebration of the Eucharist.

Why: The readings are presented in a simpler language and the children have an opportunity to reflect on the readings meaning within their daily lives.
