Dear Parish Family,

I would like to begin by quoting the Bishop's pastoral letter. He writes, "Attentiveness to quality liturgy facilitates the full, active, and conscious participation of God's people in worthy worship. For this reason, I would like



each parish and each deanery to consider weekend and daily Mass schedules... I would like each parish to consider when it offers the Sacrament of Reconciliation...I would like each parish to consider opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration." This month of October, I would encourage you to reflect upon the celebration of Mass and the importance of the Sacrament of Reconciliation in your life as a Catholic.

During the month of October, we have an opportunity to deepen our appreciation of the Holy Eucharit. On the weekend of the 11th and 12th of October, we will be celebrating our 40 Hour Devotion of the Blessed Sacrament. I would encourage you to take an hour during this weekend to simply be in the presence of the Lord. Taking from your reflection a more profound appreciation of Sunday Mass and its importance in your life and the life of your family.

Do you find Saturday afternoon the most convenient time for you to participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Prior to Christmas and Easter, the times for confession vary. Would other times assist you in making the Sacrament a more part of your spiritual journey?

Having read or maybe rereading pages 15 and 16 will help all of us become a "More Flourishing Apostolic Church. I close with a meditation from a homily by Bishop Barron:

The Church is about the business of making people holy. That's what the sacraments accomplish. Baptism draws people into the trinitarian life; the Eucharist nourishes them on the Body and Blood of the Lord; Penance restores them to grace when that relationship is compromised by sin; Confirmation strengthens them in the Holy Spirit; Holy Orders and Marriage commission people for the work of the Spirit. "One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic," Homily



The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

What is the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, and where did this sacrament of healing originate? Like all seven sacraments, it originated from the words and deeds of Jesus Christ. Before Jesus ascended into Heaven, he gave the Apostles the power to heal the sick by laying hands on them. We hear Jesus commission the Apostles in the Gospel of Mark: "Go into the world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature. In my name they will drive out demons, they will speak new languages. They will pick up serpents with their hands, and if they drink any deadly thing, it will not harm them. They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover" (Mark 16:15-18).

There are numerous accounts in *The Acts of the Apostles* where Peter and Paul healed those who were sick. The power to lay hands on someone and to heal them was passed from Jesus to the Apostles and then to the bishops and priests of the Church, and it became known as the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. The *Letter of James* gives us further scriptural evidence for the Sacrament of Anointing: "Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the Church, and they should pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven" (James 5:13-15).

For the first 800 years of the Church's existence, the Sacrament of Anointing focused on the restoration of bodily health, but under the Emperor Charlemagne in the late 8th century, the sacrament became referred to as "Extreme Unction" (unction is Latin for "anointing") as it focused on preparing people for death. With the publication of the *Summa Theologica*, by Saint Thomas Aquinas in the mid-thirteenth century, the theological shift of the sacrament was made complete. For centuries to come, the Sacrament of Anointing was administered in order to prepare a person for immanent death.

In the mid-sixteenth century, the Council of Trent slowly began restoring the original practice of the sacrament as being one that was administered to those who were sick and not necessarily on their deathbed, and this shift continued through the Second Vatican Council in the early 1960's. Finally, in 1972 Pope Paul VI established a new sacramental form of anointing and approved the new rite which is still used today: "Pastoral Care of the Sick: Rites and Anointing and Viaticum."

There are many Catholics today who still associate the Sacrament of Anointing with imminent death and what is known as the "Last Rites." Because of this association with death, some people are very hesitant or even refuse to be anointed since they don't want to tacitly admit that they are in imminent danger of dying. What many Catholics don't realize is that the "Last Rites" is not the same as the Sacrament of Anointing. A person who is not in imminent danger of death can receive the Sacrament of Anointing to help them recover from an illness.


