Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Wednesday, I am heading "across the pond" with 48 fellow pilgrims to Italy for a Jubilee Year Pilgrimage. As you have hopefully heard by now, 2025 is an Ordinary Jubilee year of hope. This means that



it is possible to receive a plenary indulgence by passing through Holy Doors in Rome, receiving Holy Communion, praying for the pope's intentions, and celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

A plenary indulgence is a special grace that wipes out any temporal punishment on one's soul, such that one's soul is returned to the same state it was in immediately following Baptism. There are a variety of ways to receive a plenary indulgence, but especially in a holy year, it is a great time to obtain one! Passing through the Holy Doors is possible for anyone; even if you cannot make it to Rome, we have over 10 sites in our diocese with local Holy Doors. You can find those sites here: https://www.dioceseofcleveland.org/pilgrims-of-hope/sacred-sites. If you are homebound, the desire to pass through the Holy Doors is enough to receive the indulgence. You must simply meet the other required criteria.

Please keep me and the other pilgrims in your prayers as we make our way to Florence, Assisi, and Rome. Know of our prayers! If you have any particular intentions you wish for us to carry with us, email me at imenkhaus@stbern.net.

Next Sunday we will take up a second collection for World Mission Sunday. In *Evangelii Nuntiandi*, St. Pope Paul VI reminds us that prayer is the soul of all mission: "It is the Holy Spirit who, today just as the beginning of the Church, acts in every evangelizer" (75). Through our prayers, we unite ourselves with missionaries bringing the Gospel to the ends of the earth. Let us offer our rosaries and Masses this week for those who bring Christ's love to the margins, often at great personal cost. And let us ask the Holy Spirit to rekindle the fire of hope in our own hearts, that we may also be missionaries, wherever we are. Book of the Names of the Dead As is our practice here at St. Bernadette, we will be placing the Book of the Names of the Dead in the Church during October. Throughout the month, parishioners are welcome to inscribe the names of deceased family and friends from the past year. Please note that our CARE Minister, Denise Feyes, will already have inscribed names of individuals who were buried from St. Bernadette since last year. Throughout the month of November, we will be remembering the names inscribed in the Book of the Names of the Dead in the General Intercessions at each of our Masses. Please feel free to write the names of your loved ones in the book.

A special Mass of the Feast of All Souls Day will be celebrated on **Friday**, **November 7th at 7:00PM** to remember all those who have entered into eternal life with Christ. The Mass will also be livestreamed from the parish website. This liturgy highlights the Paschal Mystery of Christ's death and resurrection; his victory over sin and death. The names of all those who have been buried from St. Bernadette this past year will be read at this liturgy. Our faith assures us that praying for and to those who have died strengthens our relationship with them. We invite you to join us for this very special day of prayer! All parishioners are welcome and encouraged to participate in this liturgy! There will be a gathering in the Community Room after Mass for light refreshments and fellowship.
