Dear Parish Family,

**Is Revenge Ever Justified?** Recently, a government official was asked to name his favorite biblical text. He replied, "An Eye for an Eye and a Tooth for a Tooth. (Exod 21:24) This statement of Mosaic Law in ancient Israel served as a "guideline" for judicial authorities (judges) to provide fair punishment in legal cases; neither too harsh nor too lenient. This Old



Testament civil law guarded against excessive retaliation. It never gave permission for individual persons to seek revenge.

Unfortunately, this is one of the most misunderstood texts with some exploiting it as scriptural endorsement for revenge! The Bible places it in "civil law," the aim of which was to find a balance, meaning the offender's punishment cannot exceed the crime.

In fact, there is no indication that this law of "Eye for an Eye" was followed, nor is there biblical testimony that an Israelite was maimed as punishment for injuring another in the same way. Most crimes were repaid with payment in goods or with work, eg. stealing a lamb resulted in replacing a lamb or working for the owner for a suitable time. Capital crimes were addressed with execution in ancient Israel but heard by a judge and based on multiple witnesses. (Deut 17:6-7)

In Jesus' time, perhaps 1300 or more years after the law was given to Moses, the application of the law deteriorated into individuals feeling justified to "respond in kind" to any form of hurt, insult, etc. Pettiness reared its ugly head! It still does.

The Gospels offer multiple examples of Jesus addressing personal hostility, anger, self-importance, etc. Jesus never denied the need for justice in society, but He practiced and taught a merciful approach in His personal relationships, eg. Zaccheus, Peter's Denial, Prodigal Son, etc. In **Matthew 5: 38ff**, Jesus acknowledged the "Eye for an Eye..." but follows with, "**But, I say to you...**" and offers **His teaching on Retaliation...** a read worth your time.

As God is both just and merciful, Paul writes in Roman 12:19, "Do not take revenge...leave room for God's wrath, for it is written, 'It is mine to avenge; I will repay' says the Lord."

Perhaps Paul suggests that, as brothers and sisters of Christ, we need to let go of revenge and let God be God.


#### **Knights of Columbus at St. Bernadette**
