Dear Parish Family,

Please see below the welcome remarks at our 75th Anniversary closing Mass, made by Richard Klingshirn, Chair of PPC:

We celebrate a milestone in the life of our parish. As a lifelong parishioner who has called this parish home for 64 of its 75 years, my heart is filled with joy and gratitude as we celebrate today.

This Mass marks the conclusion of a year of celebration with the Bishop's Pastoral Letter providing a roadmap of how we would celebrate as a parish, focusing on Worship, Evangelization and Service.

Last November on the Feast of Christ the King, we welcomed back to St. Bernadette, Bishop David Walkowiak, son of the parish and graduate of St. Bernadette School to celebrate our opening Mass.

Numerous events throughout the year provided our parish the opportunity to not only celebrate the Liturgy, but to worship as a parish community. Our Lenten Mission, a local pilgrimage to several sites dedicated to Our Lady of Lourdes, a nine-month Novena based on the Bishop's Pastoral Letter, Sunday evening Youth Masses, and a beautiful outdoor Mass as part of our Festival weekend are but a few of the worship activities.

Our evangelization efforts continue to grow with our Parish Family Ministries thriving with programs for middle school, high school and adults of all ages; our St. Bernadette Parish podcast has blossomed into a much anticipated opportunity to share parishioner's stories; our Heart and Harvest Festival was the largest yet allowing us to share our faith with friends, neighbors and visitors. St. Bernadette School holds a National Blue Ribbon award and continues to provide a premier Catholic education thanks to the great work of our principal and the dedicated faculty and staff.

Among the many service activities, this past year our parishioners volunteered hundreds of hours to participate in the Greater Cleveland Habitat for Humanity Faith Build program, working alongside families and other faith congregations building homes in the Mt. Pleasant neighborhood on Cleveland's east side. Our participation was made possible thanks to the generosity of our St. Bernadette school students and parents who raised over \$3,000 to kickoff the program.

We have built upon the good work of the pastors and Parochial Vicars who have come before to create a faith filled and thriving parish as we strive to be a leading example of what it means to be an Apostolic parish.

This Mass marks the end to our 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary year – it is more importantly our opportunity to look ahead and proclaim a bright future filled with hope and God's grace as we march proudly, joyfully and prayerfully forward building the Kingdom of God at St. Bernadette Parish.


# Our coat closet will reopen on Monday, December 1st!


