My Friends in Christ,

As we paused to give thanks for the many blessings that God has bestowed upon us this past week, please be assured of my thankfulness to be here with you. My assignment St. Bernadette Parish has been one of the many blessings of my diaconate ministry.



This weekend marks a lot of "newness" in the parish. It is the beginning of the new liturgical year. It's the beginning of the new Sunday Mass schedule. Lectors and extraordinary minister of Holy Communion are using a new system for scheduling.

One of the joys of my diocesan ministry is helping produce the TV Mass for those who homebound or ill and unable to attend Mass. As we recorded the TV Mass for this weekend – The First Sunday of Advent— the celebrant, Fr. Joe Mamich (vicar for clergy and religious and pastor of the cathedral), used his homily to remind the faithful that even though we've experienced Advent before, we've never experienced THIS Advent season in 2025.

So, I extend this invitation to you...find a new way to ready yourself for the celebration of the birth of Christ. Get an Advent wreath for your home, look for a new way to encounter the Lord through acts of service and charity, attend parish Advent opportunities over the next few weeks, increase or perhaps re-energize your prayer life (maybe through My Daily Prayer – dioceseofcleveland.org/mydailyprayers). While we have experienced Advent before, it's never been THIS Advent. May we be ready to experience Advent anew so that we can receive the infant Jesus in our hearts just like that manger in Bethlehem over 2000 years ago.






