St. Bernadette Church December 7, 2025

Dear Parish Family,

In the new liturgical year, we contemplate the gospel of Matthew. Scholars believe that this gospel was written in the middle of the first century. It is a gospel that witnessed to the person of Jesus the Christ to Jewish Christians in



Palestine. The content of Matthew's gospel has as its central theme, the "Kingdom of Heaven." Matthew claims that God the Father is now working through the Messiah (Jesus) to establish his will on earth, as it is in heaven.

The gospel of the birth of Jesus focuses on the silent yes of St. Joseph. St. Joseph does not speak one word. He is a man who listens and has listened. He, an observant Jew, understood the law of God's mercy. When confronted with Mary's pregnancy he chose to understand the laws call for mercy as experienced often in the history of his people. In taking Mary into his home, he said yes to doing God's will. St. Joseph is an example of true masculine strength, and one who cherished God's word. He not only accepted the faith of Israel, but acted upon it. His faith was lived out in very demanding situations of trust and dangerous decisions. I would suggest that as we reflect upon the gospel this liturgical year, we call upon St. Joseph to assist us as we hear Matthew's gospel at Mass. We will reflect upon the gospel and prayerfully respond to its invitation to act upon God's word in each situation of our lives and the life of the parish. I offer you two reflections for your meditation.

To be faithful as humble collaborators with the divine plan over our lives, we need along with the protection of the Virgin Mary, that of St. Joseph, a most powerful intercessor. —St. Pope John XXIII




Our next sandwich making day is December 10th.




