Promoting Long-term Sustainability for St. Bernadette Church and School

An initiative to create a sustainable income stream to support the vision and mission of St. Bernadette Parish (Church and School).

The Perpetual Endowed Fund has great potential to significantly impact the communal life of the parish and ensure a lasting legacy. It will provide direct benefits to the parishioners in both the school and church setting, including the much needed maintenance of buildings and grounds as well as the support of current and future ministries and programs.





Dear Parishioners,

In early Fall of 2023, I announced the establishment of the St. Bernadette Perpetual Endowed Fund. Your gifts to this fund, which are an investment in the future of St. Bernadette Church and St. Bernadette Catholic School, will be invested in perpetuity with the income to be used to support the future maintenance and operations of both the school and church.

With a short-term goal of \$2,500,000 by the end of 2025 (our 75th Anniversary year as a parish) and a long-term goal of \$5,000,000, I am asking each parishioner to consider a gift of \$3,600 to the Perpetual Endowed Fund (\$100 per month for three years). Since announcing the establishment of the fund, I am happy to report we have quietly received over \$500,000 in lead gifts which have seeded the fund. Of course, for those parishioners who have the means, I am asking you to consider a larger gift.

Thanks to the amazing generosity of our parishioners in supporting the Pious Trust, we have been able to make significant enhancements to our church and school buildings and grounds over the last 12 years — many of those enhancements were long overdue as the parish did not have the means to pay for them prior to the establishment of the Pious Trust. The Pious Trust will remain an active fund. With the Perpetual Endowed Fund, we are building a long-term, sustainable stream of income to provide the needed resources for the entire parish and the dozens of ministries and programs as well as the parish and school buildings and grounds for future generations.

I ask that you review these materials carefully and prayerfully consider a cash gift or pledge to the St. Bernadette Perpetual Endowed Fund. Additionally, I ask that you consider reviewing your estate plans and including the Perpetual Endowed Fund in your plans (or updating your estate plan if St. Bernadette is already included in your plan).
