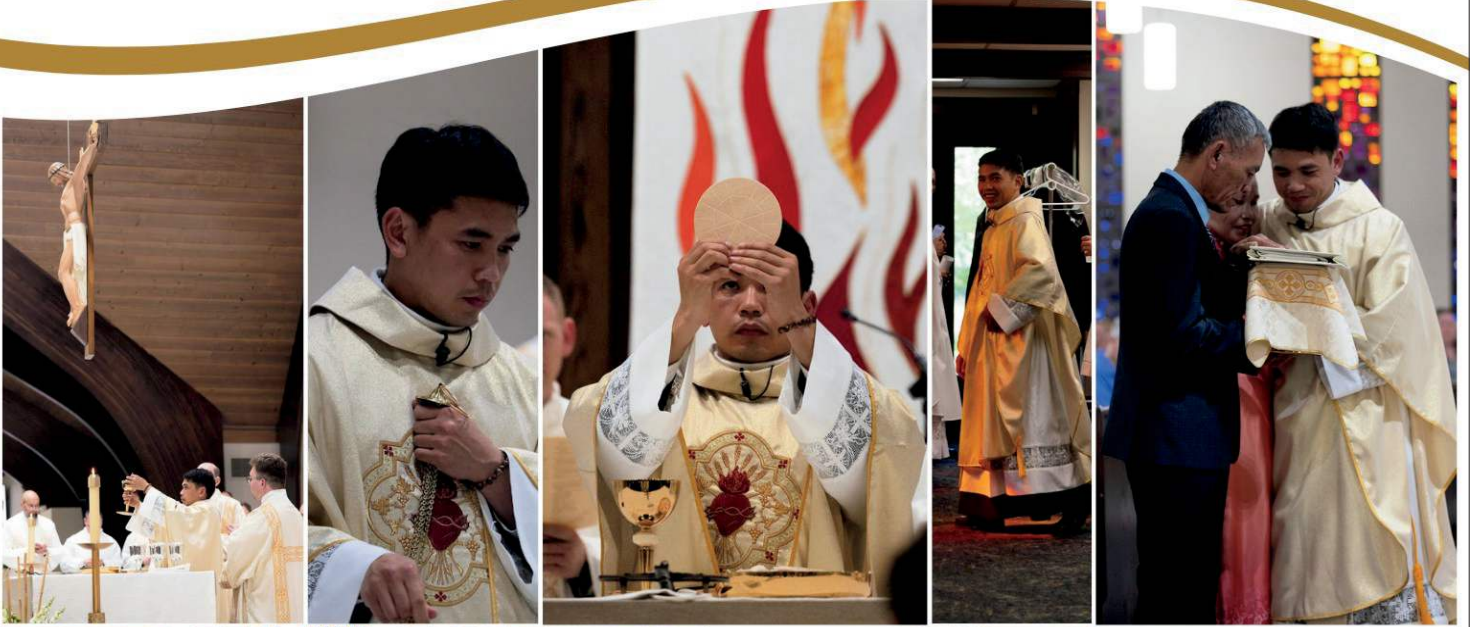


# Father Joseph Ho



Last week's Sunday Gospel mentioned the "Upper Room" where eleven of the apostles and others, including one woman named Mary, Mother of Jesus, waited for the promised Spirit. Unsurprisingly, the group huddled in fear in that Upper Room. *What do we do now? Where do we go? They did what we all do when we are frightened and scared. We pray.*



**I think Mary was NOT AFRAID.** She **knew** this Holy Spirit; this same Spirit whom she experienced at the Annunciation of Jesus's birth— this mystery of the Holy Spirit who accompanied her throughout her life. Hear Mary say, "**Continue to pray...it will be all right.**"

Traditionally, we speak of Pentecost as the "**Birthday of the Church**" when **the Holy Spirit**, often **imaged as Tongues of Fire**, empowered those gathered to continue Jesus's mission and message. "**Fire**" is a good mental image. Fire warms, illuminates, and when we see or feel it, moves us to some form of action – sometimes to stir up or perhaps to stamp out. Luke's story of Emmaus speaks of the astonishment of the apostles as they pondered the conversation with *the stranger* (Risen Christ) they met along the road. Luke records them saying, "*Weren't our hearts **burning within us** as He spoke to us on the way, opening the Scriptures for us...?*" An eagerness, impatience to spread the good news that Jesus has risen!

"**Speaking in Tongues**" reveals that each hearer, **heard** the Message of Salvation in his or her native language! Cultural barriers of every kind were erased. A transformation from fear to courage emboldened them "*to preach the mighty acts of God.*" Tell the story of God's love!

The Message of Salvation became clear to persons of every culture, race and language. Could this be the first meaning of "**unity in diversity?**"

Today, multiple barriers divide peoples and nations. We ponder as did the folks in the Upper Room, *What do we do now? Where do we go?* These are not negative questions. Quite the contrary. They are inquiries of a seeker; a person desiring to embrace the courage and conviction of Jesus – *I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life.* **Speak that Truth!** Jesus knew then and knows now, that **human beings need sustained faith, confidence and fearlessness to voice the truth.** *Where do we go?* The Holy Spirit who vitalized the leaders of the early Church at Pentecost and who birthed God's life in us at our baptism, continues the same for us now. **WE are the disciples of the contemporary Church.** Is your heart burning within you?

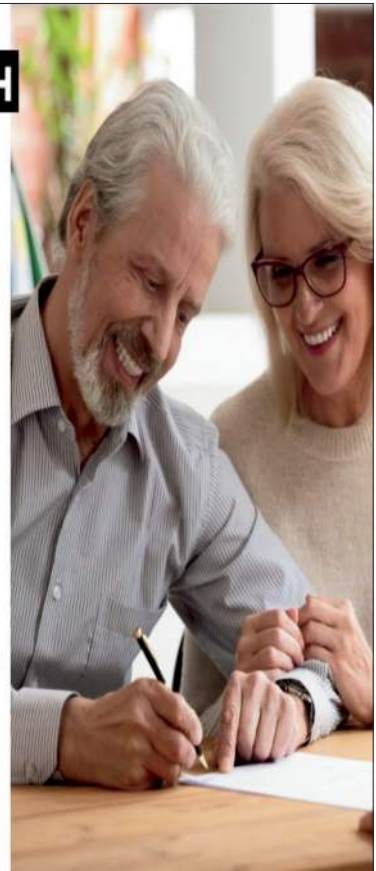
