Baptisms at St. Bernadette

Brothers and Sisters, as you know, with Fr. Phil retiring, we are now a one-priest parish. Because of this, I am doing my best to divvy up many of the pastoral responsibilities at St. Bernadette. We are blessed with the presence of Deacon Jeff Stutzman and Deacon Mark Cunningham (who is retired, but still willing to help). As ordained Deacons, they are able to assist me in many ways, and I am looking to expand their responsibilities. One way in which they have agreed to help me is with Baptisms. Going forward, the way that we will handle Baptisms at St. Bernadette is that one of the three of us will have the Baptisms each week. This means if you desire to have your child baptized, the schedule will look like this:

- First Sunday of the Month: Baptisms at 10:30 AM Mass
- Second Sunday of the Month after 10:30 AM Mass: Fr. Joe
- Third Sunday of the Month after 10:30 AM Mass: Deacon Jeff
- Fourth Sunday of the Month after 10:30 AM Mass: Deacon Mark
- Fifth Sunday of the Month after 10:30 AM Mass (If Necessary): Fr. Joe

There may, of course, be times where we may need to adjust the schedule, but this will be the general rotation.

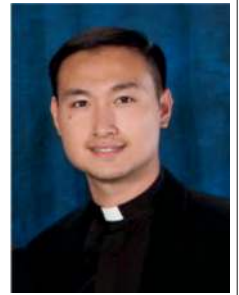
Fr. Minh Anh Dinh SVD will be at St. Bernadette Parish next weekend, July 11-12, to celebrate Masses and to speak about the many ministries of his religious community, Divine Word Missionaries. They are an international religious community of missionary priests and Brothers serving in 79 countries helping to build chapels, celebrate the sacraments and spread the Word of God in remote mission communities.

Father Minh, originally from Vietnam, moved to the United States in 2008 to pursue a business degree at the University of Illinois at Chicago. During a trip to Thailand, he encountered the missionary work of the Divine Word Missionaries, an experience that deeply influenced his vocational journey. After completing his bachelor's degree, he discerned a call to religious life and entered the Divine Word Missionaries, where he was assigned to the Chicago Province.

He was ordained to the priesthood in 2021. Fluent in Vietnamese and English, Fr. Minh also speaks Portuguese. In 2025, he completed his MBA at Loyola University Chicago and was subsequently appointed House Treasurer of the Techny Community, where he now serves in leadership and financial stewardship while continuing his priestly ministry.

Nearly 6,000 active Divine Word Missionaries minister in the far corners of the world. They build hospitals to care for the sick and schools to educate the poor. They teach the hungry to farm, and they provide life's necessities—water, food and shelter—in impoverished communities. These priests and Brothers help those neglected and forgotten by society to build a better future. They also foster vibrant Catholic communities of service and faith around the world.
