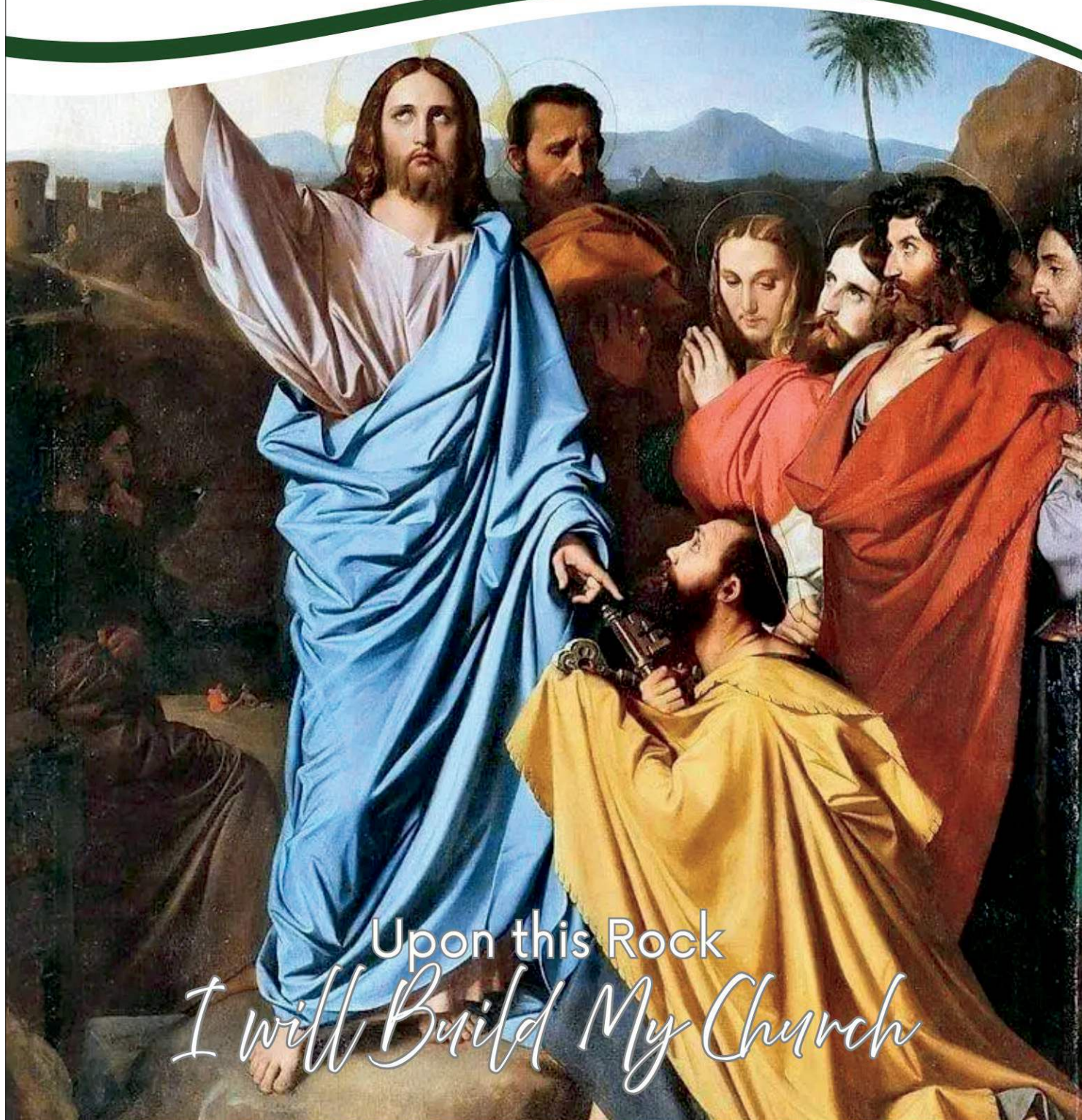

Give God the Voice He Gave You

Uh oh! Who let the organist get his hands on the bulletin column again???

The Church speaks of our participation at Mass as “full, conscious, and active participation.” This means more than simply standing, kneeling, responding, or serving. At every celebration of the Eucharist, Christ invites us to bring our whole selves—our joys, sorrows, hopes, burdens, and gratitude—and to be transformed by His love.

This is one reason singing together at Mass matters so much.

I know some of you may be thinking, “*But I don't sing!*” Maybe you don't consider yourself a singer, or someone once told you that you couldn't carry a tune. That's okay. You don't need a beautiful voice. You already have the voice God gave you. Give it back to Him.

When the Church sings, something happens that spoken words alone cannot accomplish. Hundreds of individual voices become one voice, reminding us of what the Church truly is: many people, many lives, and many stories gathered into one Body in Christ.

The choir and cantors have an important ministry, but they are not there to sing the Mass for us. Likewise, the organ is not simply there to accompany the choir. Its great purpose is to support the singing of the gathered assembly and give strength and confidence to our common voice.

So instead of asking, “*Can I hear the choir?*” during a congregational hymn, perhaps we should ask, “Can I hear the voice of the gathered assembly? Am I part of that voice?”

Will every voice be beautiful? No. Will every note be perfect? No. Does God mind? No. So sing! Sing the Gloria because there is glory to give to God. Sing the Alleluia because Christ speaks His Gospel among us. Sing the Holy, Holy, Holy because heaven and earth are full of His glory. Sing the Great Amen because the Eucharistic Prayer belongs to the whole Church.

If singing at Mass has never felt comfortable, start quietly. Let the voices around you carry you until, little by little, you begin carrying someone else.

Let us bring our whole selves to the altar—mind and heart, body and soul, silence and voice. God has given us a voice. At the Eucharistic celebration, let us give it back to Him.
