Dear Friends in Christ,

Over the past couple of weeks, I have been meeting with some of our parish servers for a "server bootcamp." It's a chance for the servers to gather (enjoy some pizza) and review the principles of this important ministry. One question I ask them to reflect on is "why are you a server?" We talk about how no matter what ministry or volunteer position you assist with at the parish, it's important to know the why. Their answers are usually along similar lines with "I want to be more active during Mass" to "it looked like fun." To which I noted, "Yes, while you need to be reverent, the ministry of serving should be fun and enjoyable."

This is also a good question for everyone, "why do you [insert name of ministry]?" And if you're currently not part of any of our ministries or volunteer opportunities, perhaps this is a great time to start thinking about it. Knowing the "why" can help energize and focus ourselves in our ministries.

Finally, we will be looking to train new servers in the coming months! After discussions with Fr. Joe and our liturgical commission, we will be recruiting servers beginning in the 4th grade. More news to come, but if you have a child in 4th grade or older (school, PSR or just as a parish family) start encouraging them to think about becoming a server and helping them develop their "why."
