



Chamber Joins National Call to Reopen the Federal Government

Earlier this month, the LaGrange County Chamber of Commerce joined a national coalition of 215 associations and state and local chambers in urging Congress to take action and reopen the federal government. This effort, led by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, aimed to end the longest government shutdown in U.S. history.

In a letter sent to lawmakers, the coalition emphasized the growing impact of the shutdown on American families, local communities, the economy, and national security. The letter applauded bipartisan efforts to identify solutions and urged Congress to immediately finalize progress and vote to reopen the government.

The U.S. Chamber expressed strong support for the Senate's legislative package to reopen the government and called on members of Congress to act swiftly. From the beginning of the shutdown, the Chamber has been vocal about the challenges it poses to small businesses and the local economy.

By joining this nationwide effort, the LaGrange County Chamber reaffirmed its commitment to advocating for a stable business environment and the well-being of our community.
