## Chapter 1 – Jesus sends the Holy Spirit.

  - ever-present and all-powerful with you.
  - the perfect Friend – knowing us better than we can know ourselves & loving us better than we can love ourselves.

## Chapter 2 – The Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit.

    - God is going to do something special for/to us
    - Gifts from God - The Holy Spirit - 7 Special Gifts – to live holy lives
      - Wisdom – see someone struggling with a difficult decision
      - Understanding – want to learn more about someone else's faith
      - Right judgement – need to make a good decision
      - Courage – need to stand up for what is right
      - Knowledge – want to learn more @ God & His plan for you
      - Piety – want to show respect and honor to God
      - Fear of the Lord – want to be in awe of God and His power
  - Soldiers of Christ – Mission: To spread the message of love, peace and hope that He taught us.
  - Virtues – we are called to heroic virtue
    - We must act virtuously as soldiers
      - Theological – GIFT from God, help us grow closer to Him & love others more.
      - Cardinal – all good choices HINGE on these 4

1. Pride – humility
2. Greed – generosity
3. Wrath – patience
4. Envy – kindness
5. Gluttony – temperance
6. Lust – chastity
7. Sloth – diligence

Examples of using virtues:

**Faith** – *belief & Trust in God*

- **Daily prayer** - pray simple, consistent prayers
- **Storytelling** – reading bible or saint stories
- **Honesty** – admitting mistakes

**Hope** – *Expecting God's Goodness*

- **Waiting** – build patience to wait well for future good things from God
- **Goals** – talk about plans for when grow up and what mission God is calling them to
- **Looking for Good** – find the good in situations even when things are hard

**Love** – *Love for God & Neighbor*

- **Acts of Service** – help family, friends and the community
- **Sharing & Generosity** – share toys, treats
- **Compassion** – show care for others who are sad or hurt

**Prudence** – *wisdom / good choices*

- **Making choices** – choose – which one will help you learn best, which choice is kindest, healthiest
- **Planning** – plan to build a tower with blocks or organize toys for a game

**Justice** – *fairness / respect*

- **sharing**- taking turns with a coveted toy or sharing art supplies during a project.
- **Respect** – practicing “please” and “thank you”, listening when others speak, respecting personal space
- **Equality** – ensuring everyone gets a turn on the swing or that a shared snack is divided equally

**Fortitude** – *courage /perseverance*

- **trying new things** – new food, climb a little higher on the playground, speak to a new friend
- **standing up for others** – telling a bully to stop or including a lonely child in their game
- **perseverance** – continuing a puzzle or drawing even when it gets difficult.

**Temperance** – *self-control / moderation*

- **moderation** – limiting screen time or candy or good stuff
- **patience** – waiting for a turn without whining or resisting the urge to interrupt
- **responsibility** – doing chores without being asked, (ex. putting toys away after playing)

- Will – do that
- Irascible passion / appetite – help overcome obstacles
- Sense appetite – go toward those that are pleasant
