North Course - Par 72

- Modern Design Elements and Dynamic Layout
- String of 18 holes with a 13 hole Evening Routing
- Monitored Flow and Pace of Play
 - Target 4 hours and 30 minutes or less
- Premium Golf Experience at an Affordable Price
- Cart included with Green Fee and optional for package holders at \$10 half cart rate

Exceptional Course Conditions and Maintenance Philosophy

- Modernized maintenance facilities and new equipment
- Access to water from the Bay of Quinte provides unmatched conditions despite exceptionally hot and dry weather
- North Course
 - Large greens and tees (average green size 6500+)
 - Addition of new tee decks during the 2025 season
 - \circ 10,000 sq ft of tee deck on each par 3

Unmatched Accessibility

- Two 18 hole Courses
 - Better access to tee times for package holders and public players
 - 6:30am Friday to Sunday starts
- Equitable package offerings with low round commitment
- Focus on package holders, green fee and stay and play guests with limited number of shotgun tournaments

- 10 Minute Tee Time Intervals
- Continuous investment to improve course conditioning and customer experience
- Six tee blocks tailored to suit the skill level of all players
- Flexible Rate Structure

South Course

- \$10 half cart rate for all package holders
- 10 Pack Limited offers reduced rates with time of play restrictions
- Available to South Course package holders at golf plan rates
