Meet this Sunday's Guest Speaker

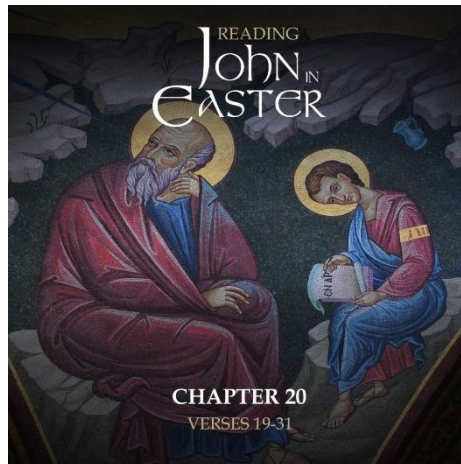
