TIRES AND REPAIRS



A flat tire doesn't always mean the tire needs replaced. After a thorough inspection, a flat tire may qualify to be safely repaired if the damage is within acceptable size and location on the tire tread.

A tire puncture greater than 1/4 inch (or 6mm) cannot be repaired. A new tire replacement is needed if a puncture exceeds this limit. Large tread punctures, irregular gashes, or cuts exceeding 1/4 inch cannot be repaired. If a cut slices through the tire's steel belts, it reduces the strength and durability of the tire, making it unreliable and unsafe.

Not all tires can be repaired. Some have special tire repair limits and others may have suffered damage too extensive to repair. Returning a permanently weakened or incorrectly repaired tire to service could result in tire failure. Our policy uses strict guidelines to keep you safe.

Grab one that suits your vehicle height and width, don't strain using the incorrect brush!




