Snow Removal



Village crews work hard to salt and plow our streets during every winter storm. You can help them do their job safely and efficiently by moving your vehicle off the street whenever possible.

Please also be courteous when clearing snow from your property. For everyone's safety, property owners are responsible for keeping their sidewalks clear. When sidewalks are not shoveled, pedestrians are forced into the street, creating dangerous conditions.

Remember to keep all removed snow on your property – never on a neighbor's lot or back into the roadway. A helpful tip: when facing the street, shovel snow to the right side of your driveway. This reduces the amount of snow that may be pushed back into your driveway when the plows come through.

Thank you for helping keep our community safe this winter.

Shelter House Reservation

Please note an important change for this year's shelter reservations. Online reservations will now always open on **March 1 at 12:01 a.m.**, regardless of the day of the week. Rental fees remain \$60 for shelters with restrooms and \$40 for shelters without restrooms. The **new Paris Street shelter is not reservable**, while the **old Paris Street shelter may still be reserved until construction begins later this year**. For those wishing to reserve in person, **in-office reservations will begin on March 1**, unless that date falls on a weekend, in which case reservations will start on the **next business day**.
