Treatment of Physicians and Staff

We have a **zero tolerance abuse policy**. Any abusive behaviour directed towards physicians, staff or other patients will result in you no longer being a patient at Ursus Care Clinic (UCC).

Appointments

Ursus Care Clinic aims to provide same or next day family practice appointments. A main health issue will be addressed and additional issues if time permits. This ensures physicians can focus and properly address a patient's health issues during the appointment. Additional appointments can always be booked.

In Person and Telehealth Appointments

We emphasize in-person visits to ensure quality patient care. Phone appointments are acceptable to address some health issues, such as prescription refills or discussion of test results. They are not acceptable for the majority of referrals.

Family Medicine is a constantly advancing field. Physicians at UCC will use their clinical judgement to order investigations, labs and request referrals. We require you collaborate with UCC physicians to address your health.

Patient Ending Care at Ursus Care Clinic

You can end your care under a physician at UCC at any time. Inform any staff member of the clinic.

Dismissal from Ursus Care Clinic

You will no longer be a patient at UCC for any of the following:

- Refusing to collaborate with UCC physicians to address your health.
- Clearly stating non-confidence in your physician: directly to their physician or a staff member at UCC.
- Regularly seeing other doctors for care that could otherwise be done at UCC.
- Refusing to attend any in-person appointments, and demanding all appointments be tele-health only.
- Refusal to pay for services. Please inform UCC of any financial distress.
