Trawalla Primary School has decided to use a closed-circuit television (CCTV) system at our school.

CCTV will also provide enhanced capability to protect our school's assets against vandalism and theft.

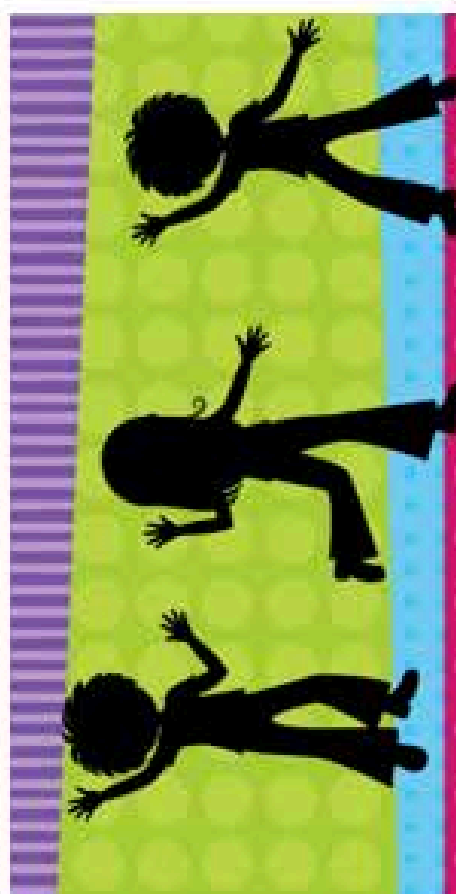
