World Oceans Day

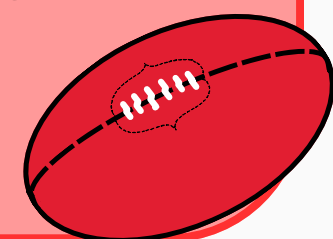
