

Altar Server Parent/Guardian Agreement

Altar serving is an important ministry of the Church in which children can become more actively engaged in the Mass. By volunteering to be an altar server your child is taking a more active role in his or her faith. This commitment is a responsibility that he or she will need your support to fulfill.

Altar Servers need to be at Church at least 15 minutes early on the day that they are serving Mass. If an altar server knows in advance that he or she cannot make his or her scheduled time it is up to that individual to find a substitute.

By signing below, I agree that my child has permission to be trained as an altar server.

I affirm that my child has received their First Communion and possesses the maturity to fulfill the duties of an altar server.

I agree to support my child in this ministry by ensuring his or her prompt arrival to Mass (at least 15 minutes prior to the Mass that he or she is scheduled to serve).

In the event my child is unable to serve at a Mass they have been scheduled for, I will help them request a substitute by contacting the server coordinator.
