

FUNERAL PRE-PLANNING CHECKLIST

Use the checklist below when discussing funeral plans with a loved one, to make sure that his or her final wishes are carried out.

ARRANGEMENTS TO DISCUSS

- Creation of a will or trust
- Appoint legal professionals for estate/property planning
- Discuss finances and how to pay for funeral or cremation services
- Locate and gather important Vital Statistics Information for Death Record

FUNERAL SERVICE IDEAS TO DISCUSS

The Type of Service

- Traditional funeral service with burial and graveside service
- Burial with simple graveside service
- Memorial service followed by cremation
- Memorial service after cremation
- Cremation with simple ash scattering service
- Direct Cremation
- Simple funeral service at home or other location followed by burial or cremation
- Celebration of life ceremony

Other funeral service events

- Viewing before burial or cremation
- Reception after funeral
- Veteran/military *Locate DD214
- Pet memorialization
- Charity for donations
- Share account information for utilities, subscription services, and other bills
- Discuss next of kin and power of attorney
- Delegate a caregiver for any children or pets at the time of need

PERSONALIZATION OPTIONS

- List of songs to play at funeral service
- Decide on food/snacks/beverages to be serviced at reception/service
- Choose the theme, colors, or special design requests
- Determine special locations for a reception or gathering
- Gather specific photos or tribute videos
- Note readings, poems or prayers for during funeral/memorial service
- Designate pallbearers
- Select a funeral celebrant or officiator
- Pick types of flowers / color schemes for florals at funeral service

- "I know it's not the most fun topic, but I've been meaning to talk to you about what I'd want when I'm not around."
