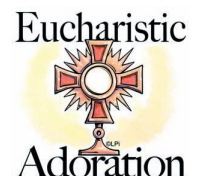

April 19, 2026

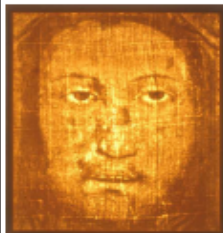
