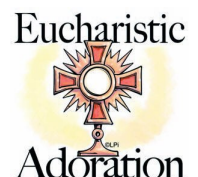

During this time when people are anxious and fearful, what are we doing to welcome others, and to love and be of service to them.



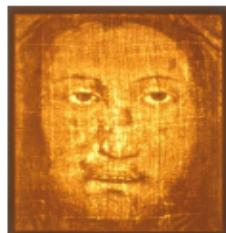
FATHER'S DAY NOVENA

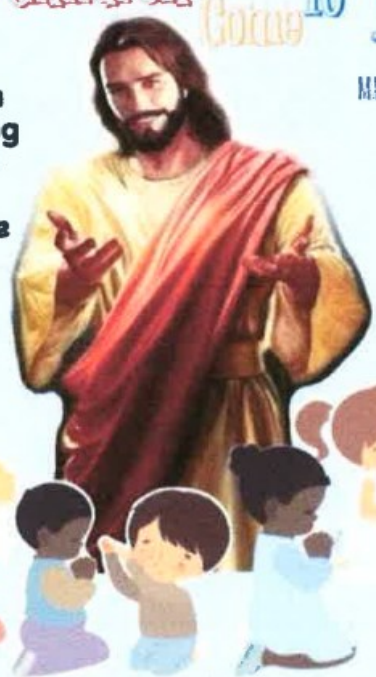

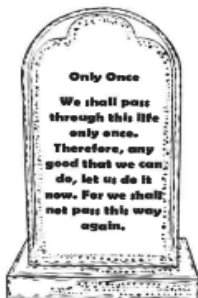

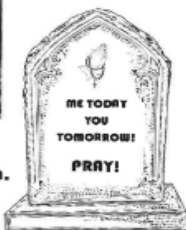
