LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

This past year marked an important milestone for the Foundation as we moved into the Athens Armory. In many ways, the Armory is a physical expression of the kind of community we are working to build, a place that holds space for our shared past, builds on our present strengths, and creates opportunities for people to come together to co-create a stronger future for Athens County. The Armory has long held historical, civic, and cultural significance in Athens County. After decades of limited use, it has reopened as a vibrant hub for gathering, working, and connecting. We are honored and grateful to be part of its next chapter.

Your generosity, your trust, and your commitment to this community make our work possible. We are deeply grateful for the role you play in strengthening Athens County. When we look back on the past fiscal year, what stands out is not only what we funded, but how we worked, with intention, with care, and with a continued focus on long-term impact.

Over the past year, the Foundation awarded **\$831,949.57** in grants across Athens County, supporting essential services, community-driven projects, and organizations deeply rooted in place. These investments address immediate needs, but they also support a broader commitment to strengthening the systems and relationships that allow our community to thrive. **We also know that grants alone are not enough.**

Nonprofit organizations can do more with philanthropic support when they are strong, connected, and well supported. That is why we continue to invest not only in grantmaking, but in programs and partnerships that strengthen the broader community.

Over the past year, we advanced that work in several ways. We continued to invest in community leadership through Leadership Athens County, which now includes more than 400 alumni across its programs. With the program's 20th anniversary in 2026, this growing network reflects our sustained investment in the people shaping this county's future.

We also convened partners around complex challenges through Co-Create, creating space for shared learning and collaborative action. Through Strengths + Strengths, we worked alongside nonprofit organizations to strengthen capacity, deepen relationships, and support long-term sustainability.

In this way, the Foundation's work creates a compounding effect. Grants support important work. Programs strengthen the conditions for that work to succeed. Relationships connect those efforts into something more coordinated, more resilient, and more impactful over time.

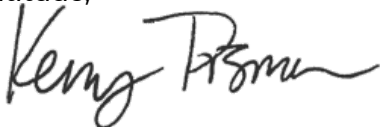
This past year, that work was recognized in a meaningful way when the Athens County Foundation was named one of 26 Civic Hubs nationwide by the Trust for Civic Life. This designation reflects the Foundation's role as a convener, a place where people can come together, engage in dialogue, and work across differences to strengthen our community; it also recognizes the strength of our community and what is possible when we work together.

We were also encouraged by the continued growth of our philanthropic community. Each new fund established and every contribution made represents an investment in Athens County and a belief in the power of working together. That belief is central to our work.

PROGRAMS

Leadership Athens County Flagship

Over an 8-month course, LAC participants are challenged to question their understanding of Athens' economic, political, social, and cultural landscape through discussions of current issues and conversations with community leaders. They learn about a complex array of topics, including poverty, food insecurity, regional employment, economic development, housing, transportation, arts and culture, history, health care options, behavioral health, prisons, natural resources, and education – all while making important personal and professional connections.

Leadership Athens County Youth

Leadership Athens County - Youth is aimed at developing a corps of informed leaders to provide dynamic community leadership now and in the future. These leaders will have the tools to identify, engage with, and work to solve challenges, ensuring residents of Athens County can live – and thrive – here.

Project Co-Create

Through Project Co-Create, we will define and activate a participatory change-making model so that Athens County can collaboratively develop solutions to address challenges and pursue opportunities with greater efficiency, speed, reach, and impact.

Strengths + Strengths

Strengths+Strengths is a special initiative designed to provide nonprofit organizations throughout Athens County with access to professional resources, expert insights, and leading best practices. The goal is to help those who do good do even better.
