prosperity. He failed miserably.

Despite allegations of corruption, war crimes, and attacks on journalists, the Rajapaksa government had a powerful mandate, which was reinforced nine months later when the brothers' party, Sri Lanka Podujana Peramuna (the Sri Lanka People's Front), won a two-thirds majority in Parliament. Yet during his short tenure, the Rajapaksas drove the country into bankruptcy, food insecurity, and spiraling inflation. Gotabaya announced his candidacy just days after the 2019 Easter Sunday bombings, promising a strong response to terrorism. In the months that

followed, newspapers' and radio stations' frenzied coverage heightened people's fear of Muslims (who comprise 10% of the population), and attacks on them increased.

Gotabaya capitalized on this environment, portraying himself as a defender of the Sinhala-Buddhist majority who would transform Sri Lanka into a Singapore of the Indian Ocean. The clergy, media, military, political elites, and local business tycoons all adopted the same rhetoric, tying their fortunes to his. The Buddhist clergy, for example, continuously reaffirmed their trust in Gotabaya throughout his presidency. In return, he established a Buddhist Advisory Council of notable monks to help guide his policy decisions. Even in January of this year, as families began rationing food, and as the central bank sold its remaining gold reserves to pay back an international bond, the Buddhist establishment spoke up for Gotabaya, arguing that he was still the only leader who could save the country.

By March, hospitals were reporting shortages of essential medicines, and two elderly men died while queuing for gasoline. Unable to pay for fuel to produce electricity, the government instituted rolling blackouts that culminated in 13-hour power cuts at the height of a suffocating heat wave. That was the final straw. Protesters stormed the streets and demanded the Rajapaksas' resignations.



WASHINGTON, DC – In a win for democracy, mass protests in Sri Lanka recently led to the resignation of President Gotabaya Rajapaksa and Prime Minister Mahinda Rajapaksa. A strongman who won popularity for overseeing the end of Sri Lanka's civil war in 2009 (while his older brother, Mahinda, was president), Gotabaya was elected in November 2019 and promised to safeguard national security and deliver

Surveillance is pervasive:

Yes, you are being watched, even if no one is looking for you

The U.S. has the largest number of surveillance cameras per person in the world. Cameras are omnipresent on city streets and in hotels, restaurants, malls and offices. They're also used to screen passengers for the Transportation Security Administration. And then there are smart doorbells and other home security cameras.

Most Americans are aware of video surveillance of public spaces. Likewise, most people know about online tracking – and want Congress to do something about it. But as a researcher who studies digital culture and secret communications, I believe that to understand how pervasive surveillance is, it's important to recognize how physical and digital tracking work together.

Databases can correlate location data from smartphones, the growing number of private cameras, license plate readers on police cruisers and toll roads, and facial recognition technology, so if law enforcement wants to track where you are and where you've been, they can. They need a warrant to use cellphone search equipment: Connecting your device to a mobile device forensic tool lets them extract and analyze all your data if they have a warrant.

However, private data brokers also track this kind of data and help surveil citizens – without a warrant. There is a large market for personal data, compiled from information people volunteer, information people unwittingly yield – for example, via mobile apps – and information that is stolen in data breaches. Among the customers for this largely unregulated data are federal, state and local law enforcement agencies.

How you are tracked

Whether or not you pass under the gaze of a surveillance camera

or license plate reader, you are tracked by your mobile phone. GPS tells weather apps or maps your location, Wi-Fi uses your location, and cell-tower triangulation tracks your phone. Bluetooth can identify and track your smartphone, and not just for COVID-19 contact tracing, Apple's "Find My" service, or to connect headphones.

People volunteer their locations for ride-sharing or for games like Pokémon Go or Ingress, but apps can also collect and share location without your knowledge. Many late-model cars feature telematics that track locations – for example, OnStar or Bluelink. All this makes opting out impractical.

The same thing is true online. Most websites feature ad trackers and third-party cookies, which are stored in your browser whenever you visit a site. They identify you when you visit other sites so advertisers can follow you around. Some websites also use key logging, which monitors what you type into a page before hitting submit. Similarly, session recording monitors mouse movements, clicks, scrolling and typing, even if you don't click "submit."

Ad trackers know when you browsed where, which browser you used, and what your device's internet address is. Google and Facebook are among the main beneficiaries, but there are many data brokers slicing and dicing such information by religion, ethnicity, political affiliations, social media profiles, income and medical history for profit.

Big Brother in the 21st century

People may implicitly consent to some loss of privacy in the interest of perceived or real security – for example, in stadiums, on the road and at airports, or in return for cheaper online services. But these trade-offs benefit individuals far less than the companies aggregating data. Many Americans are suspicious of government censuses, yet they willingly share their jogging routines on apps like Strava, which has revealed sensitive and secret military data.

In the post-Roe v. Wade legal environment, there are concerns not only about period tracking apps but about correlating data on physical movements with online searches



and phone data. Legislation like the recent Texas Senate Bill 8 anti-abortion law invokes "private individual enforcement mechanisms," raising questions about who gets access to tracking data.

In 2019, the Missouri Department of Health stored data about the periods of patients at the state's lone Planned Parenthood clinic, correlated with state medical records. Communications metadata can reveal who you are in touch with, when you were where, and who else was there – whether they are in your contacts or not.

Location data from apps on hundreds of millions of phones lets the Department of Homeland Security track people. Health wearables pose similar risks, and medical experts note a lack of awareness about the security of data they collect. Note the resemblance of your Fitbit or smartwatch to ankle bracelets people wear during court-ordered monitoring.

The most pervasive user of tracking in the U.S. is Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), which amassed a vast amount of information without judicial, legislative or public oversight. Georgetown University Law Center's Center on Privacy and Technology reported on how ICE searched the driver's license photographs of 32% of all adults in the U.S., tracked cars in cities home to 70% of adults, and updated address records for 74% of

adults when those people activated new utility accounts.

No one is watching the watchers.

Nobody expects to be invisible on streets, at borders, or in shopping centers. But who has access to all that surveillance data, and how long it is stored? There is no single U.S. privacy law at the federal level, and states cope with a regulatory patchwork; only five states – California, Colorado, Connecticut, Utah and Virginia – have privacy laws.

It is possible to limit location tracking on your phone, but not to avoid it completely. Data brokers are supposed to mask your personally identifiable data before selling it. But this "anonymization" is meaningless since individuals are easily identified by cross-referencing additional data sets. This makes it easy for bounty hunters and stalkers to abuse the system.

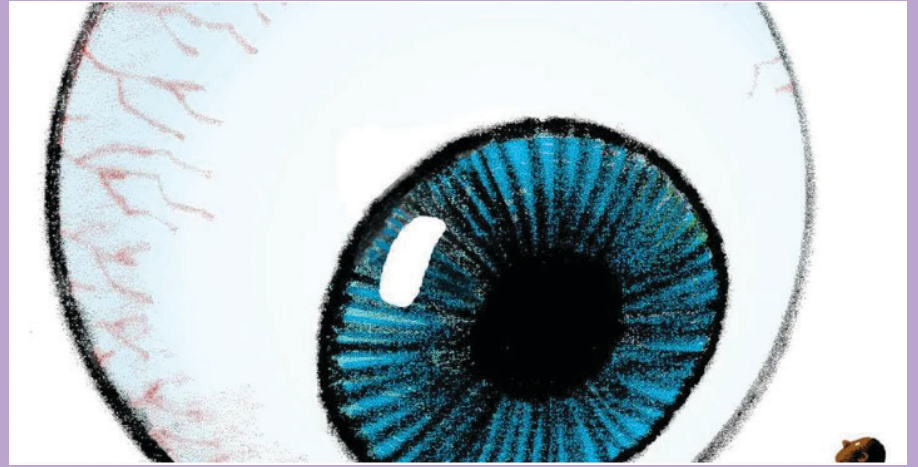
The biggest risk to most people arises when there is a data breach, which is happening more often – whether it is a leaky app or careless hotel chain, a DMV data sale or a compromised credit bureau, or indeed a data brokering middleman whose cloud storage is hacked.

This illicit flow of data not only puts fuzzy notions of privacy in peril, but may put your addresses and passport numbers, biometric data and social media profiles, credit card numbers and dating profiles, health and insurance information, and more on sale.

Sex and Surveillance



Consensual sex between adults is no one else's business. But now that public figures are susceptible to being watched three-dimensionally, the chances of being compromised are far higher than they were in the days of the UK's Profumo affair.

It is impossible to hear about sexual or sex-crime scandals nowadays – whether that involving Dominique Strauss-Kahn or those of former New York Governor Eliot Spitzer, Italian Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi, or the half-dozen United States congressmen whose careers have ended in the past couple of years – without considering how they were exposed. What does it mean to live in a society in which surveillance is omnipresent?

Like the heat beneath the proverbial boiling frogs, the level of surveillance in Western democracies has been ratcheted up slowly – but far faster than citizens can respond. In

the US, for example, George W. Bush's Patriot Act was extended, following a series of backroom deals. Americans did not want it, and they were not consulted when it was enacted by their representatives under the pressure of a government that demanded more power in the wake of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. That does not seem to matter.

A concerted effort is underway in the US – and in the United Kingdom – to “brand” surveillance as positive. New York City subway passengers are now advised that they might experience random searches of their bags. Activists in America are now accustomed to assuming that their emails are being read and their phone calls monitored. Indeed, the telecom companies Verizon and AT&T have established areas on their premises for eavesdropping activity by the National Security Agency.

NOT MANY GOT THE MEMO

Yes, I'm trying to bring that good old one back ("Did you get the memo?"). That's about all I can incredulously come up with when reading the financial news. It's as if most of the world collectively has their heads sunk in the sand: We are experiencing a slow-down. That's the memo, folks.

And, really, I don't want to be a party pooper but we've had nine strong bull years in the market and more in the economy. We've experienced many, many new stock records and the party is winding down. Things are changing.

ECONOMIC GRAVITY

It also has to be said that the financial media are underestimating the effects of inflation. We've printed up about \$6 trillion in two years. This is an extra 40 percent added to our money supply. That's a big deal!

In my August 2021 article, this was highlighted and back then the writing was already on the wall: Inflation was going to happen. Print a lot of money? Expect a lot of inflation, eventually.

ONE FOOT IN A REC***SION

I don't even like to mention the r-word (recession). Yet we have one foot in already. U.S. GDP has dipped for the most-recent quarter. It was initially down 1.3% and then revised down even lower to 1.5 percent!

Now that's not earth-shattering but after factoring in inflation that's pretty weak. But don't they already factor-in inflation? Yes, but do you believe the government numbers? So we can safely assume even larger inflation and therefore even larger GDP weakness. I also don't want to be alarmist but we, as investors, have to dig down and get prepared.

Unfortunately, there are other cracks in the dam. Retail weakness is happening. The biggie was when Wal-Mart missed their earnings numbers. The pros expected one number and it came in lower. That's a miss. Other retailers, too. Many hit or beat expectations, though.

Housing has been a big, big driver of the economy and usually always is. For good or bad. This time around it's been helping us out a lot, though. When you add direct and related real estate industries, housing is a good 20 percent or more of our economy. And we've got just a small bit of weakness now, from existing home sales to pricing drops and a few more negative indicators.

The Federal Reserve is also pushing along a slow-down. They've raised rates and it looks like they'll do it again and maybe more after that. So...that's just not good for the economy. Cost of borrowing increases for businesses, consumers decrease spending and refinancing, companies start really missing earnings, it's a large snowball effect.

WHAT TO DO?

There's quite a bit to do to reposition your portfolios. As mentioned last article, consider selling gains, lowering risky and volatile investments, upping your low-risk and short-term bonds, keeping cash, switching to value stocks, and making sure your investments produce above-average income.

There's a lot of detail that goes into those move but, for example,

DON'T LOSE HOPE

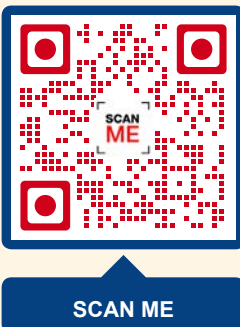

7 Ways to Have the Best Budget Meeting Ever

With skyrocketing prices everywhere you turn these days, it's more important than ever to take control of your money by making and sticking to a monthly budget. And I'm a big believer that every married couple should have a monthly budget meeting because it's so important that you both have a say in the household finances.

But as a natural spender, I have to admit that budgeting is not always my favorite thing. The good news is there's no rule that says the meeting can't be fun! So here are my tips for having the most fun and productive budget meeting ever. (To all my single friends out there, you can and should still make a monthly budget. Find a trusted friend or family member to hold you accountable and cheer you on, and you'll be well on your way to crushing your own financial goals.)

1. Put it on your calendar

In our busy household, if we don't actually schedule something, it's not going to happen. Give your budget meeting a date and time just like you'd schedule a doctor's appointment. Then give every single dollar of your income a job before you spend it by assigning it to a budget category. Make any adjustments you need to make until you can subtract your expenses from your income and get zero.

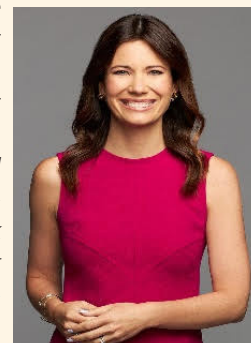

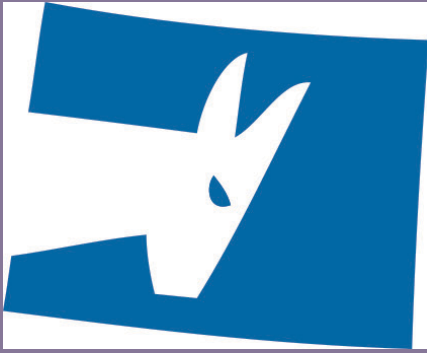
7. Stay positive

Rep. Boebert Introduces Bill to Reduce Gas Prices and Restore American Energy Dominance

Congresswoman Lauren Boebert introduced the Fueling American Prosperity Act to lower gas prices, increase domestic production, and restore American energy dominance.

Congresswoman Lauren Boebert stated, “The solution to high gas prices is simple: drill baby drill. We have an abundance of domestic natural resources just waiting to be unleashed. America produces energy cleaner and safer than anyone else in the world. Sadly, the Biden regime decided to unilaterally shut down American energy dominance on day one and we are all paying the price at the pump. The Biden regime has proven time and time again that it would rather pander to extremists and rely on dirty foreign oil than safely produce American energy that creates American jobs. It’s time to restore American energy dominance and re-

duce gas prices which is exactly what my bill will do.

Requiring the Biden regime to submit a new 5-year offshore oil and gas leasing program.

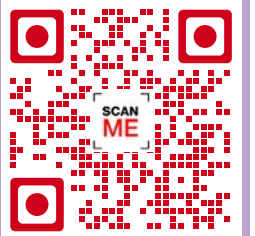

ing safety. Under this provision, environmental assessments would be capped at 1 year, and environmental impact statements would be capped at 2 years when gas prices are at an unacceptable level.

Additionally, Congresswoman Boebert’s Fueling American Prosperity Act contains built-in accountability provisions. If the Biden regime fails to meet the above requirements, Congresswoman Boebert’s bill would impose a hiring freeze on government bureaucrats at the Department of the Interior.

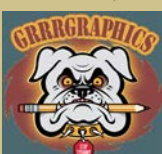

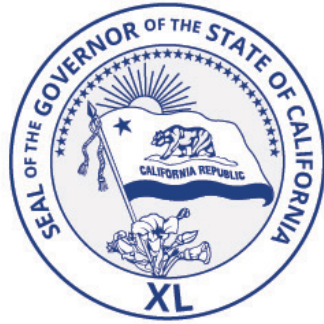

Gun Legislation Sponsored by Governor Newsom Moves Forward

Legislation called for by Governor Newsom will enable private citizens to hold the gun industry accountable through civil litigation

SACRAMENTO - The California Senate Judiciary Committee passed SB 1327, private right of action legislation authored by Senator Robert Hertzberg (D-Van Nuys) and sponsored by Governor Gavin Newsom to limit the spread of assault weapons and ghost guns. Following the U.S. Supreme Court's decision last December allowing Texas's ban on most abortion services to remain in place, Governor Newsom directed his Administration to work with the Legislature to propose a measure, modeled on the structure of Texas's abortion law, to enable private citizens to hold the gun industry accountable through civil litigation for the proliferation of illegal firearms.



weapons, .50 BMG rifles, ghost guns, or ghost gun kits.

"I am proud to be working with Governor Newsom and his Administration to bring accountability to gun manufacturers and others who are flooding our streets with dangerous and deadly weapons," said Senator Hertzberg. "The alarm bells are blaring. We could not have a clearer call for action to stop gun violence than what happened on Sunday at the doorstep of our state's democracy. The Legislature will act."

Senator Hertzberg's bill is part of a larger legislative package supported by Governor Newsom to strengthen gun laws and protect Californians. In February, the Governor highlighted additional gun safety legislation, including AB 1594 by Assemblymembers Philip Ting (D-San Francisco), Mike Gipson (D-Carson) and Christopher Ward (D-San Diego), which would allow individuals and the California Attorney General to sue manufacturers and sellers of firearms for the harm caused by their products. AB 2571 by Assemblymember Rebecca Bauer-Kahan (D-Orinda) would restrict marketing of firearms to minors. And AB 1621 by Assemblymember Gipson seeks to further restrict the proliferation of ghost guns.

Governor Newsom's proposed Real Public Safety Plan would create a new statewide gun buyback program to provide matching grants and safe-disposal opportunities to get guns off our



streets, education and training efforts related to gun violence restraining orders and \$10.3 million for local law enforcement agencies to support the seizure of firearms from individuals prohibited from possessing them.

Governor Newsom Statement on Actions Taken by the Biden Administration on Gun Control

SACRAMENTO - In a move to address proliferating gun violence, the Biden Administration today announced new actions to better regulate the manufacturing of kits used to make dangerous ghost guns. President Biden's announcement comes on the heels of recent actions taken by Governor Gavin Newsom and the California State Legislature to strengthen gun laws, regulate ghost guns, and quell the epidemic of gun violence

California pioneered statewide gun safety protections, approved by voters in Proposition 63, to ban possession of large-capacity ammunition magazines and require background checks to keep ammunition out of the hands of dangerous people. Since assuming office, Governor Newsom has signed multiple bills aimed at reducing gun violence, including strengthening gun violence restraining orders, regulating the sale of firearms and ammunition and accelerating the regulation of ghost guns. The 2021 state budget

invested \$200 million in the CalVIP program, which supports initiatives designed to break the cycle of violence in disproportionately impacted communities. The budget also provided \$11 million to facilitate ou-

seen across California and the nation.

"I salute the actions taken by the Biden Administration that align with the nation-leading efforts we have been implementing in California to address the scourge of gun violence threatening the safety of our schools, workplaces, houses of worship, and throughout our communities.

"California will not stand idly by as gun manufacturers, traffickers and others spread death and carnage on our streets. We will continue to lead efforts to save lives and work to ensure policies originating in California become a model for other states and the nation."

Since taking office, Governor Newsom has signed into law numerous bills to reduce gun rights, including fast-tracking the regulation of ghost guns, strengthening firearm restraining orders, and regulating the sale of guns and ammunition. This month, legislation sponsored by the Governor - SB 1327, which will enable private citizens to hold the gun industry and others accountable through civil litigation for the spread of illegal ghost guns and other deadly firearms - was approved by the California Senate Judiciary Committee.

The Colorado General Assembly

The Colorado General Assembly consists of 100 members - 35 Senators and 65 Representatives. Senators serve four-year terms, while Representatives serve two-year terms. All members are limited to serving for eight consecutive years in their chamber - four terms for Representatives and two terms for Senators. As of the 2010 census, State Senators serve an average of 143,691 residents and State Representatives serve an average of 77,372 residents.

The President of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Majority and Minority Leaders of each chamber serve as the primary leadership for the legislature. These six members are responsible for the day-to-day operations of the House and Senate as well as serving as the oversight authority for the legislative service agencies. Each house elects additional leadership positions as well.

SENATE EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP

The Executive Leadership of the Senate includes the Senate President, Majority Leader, and Minority Leader. They are also ex officio members of the Executive Committee of the Legislative Council along with the Executive Leadership of the House of Representatives. The President is elected by a majority vote of the Senate, while the Majority Leader and Minority Leader are chosen by their respective caucuses.

Each state in the United States elects two senators, regardless of the state's population. Senators serve six-year terms with staggered elections. Americans in the United States's six territories do not have senators.

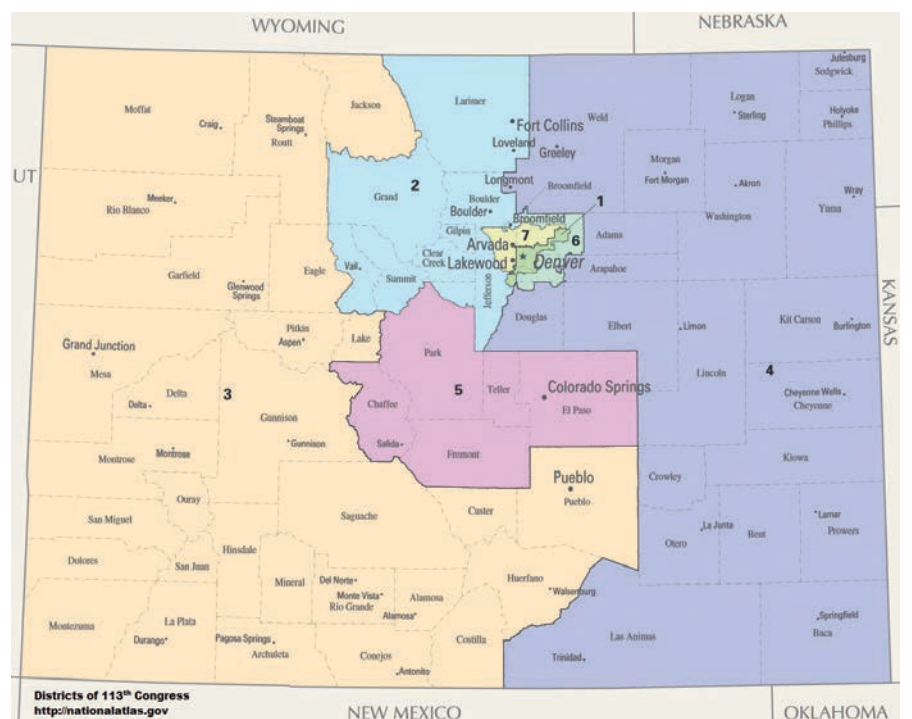
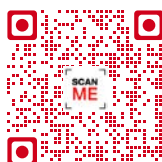
REPRESENTATIVES

Each district elects a representative to the House of Representatives for a two-year term. Representatives are also called congressmen/congresswomen. Has True the Vote told law enforcement, the FBI, elected officials?

We did involve federal and state officials and law enforcement and are working with those who wish to act. Unfortunately, some are not willing to work with us which is why we are encouraging all Americans to take action in their state to ensure free and fair elections.

Why doesn't 2000 Mules show the same person going to multiple drop boxes as claimed?

We do have video showing the same person at multiple drop boxes. Some of that footage was shown in the first trailer. It was taken out because the video is extremely poor quality.

We address this issue in the film. Most jurisdictions had no video or if they did,

it was (illegally) destroyed. Of what does exist, 85% of it is bad; the camera poorly positioned, out of focus, the video compiled out of chronological sequence, inexplicably missing blocks of days and times.

This is why the geospatial evidence is the key.

One thing this exercise proved to us is that drop box surveillance video was never monitored, as voters expected it would be. Like so many other election processes, it was a false promise of security.

At this time, we only have research in Georgia, Arizona, Wisconsin, Michigan, and Pennsylvania. Our objective is to expand our research and our investigation into more states but in the meantime, you can also take action. Please see the next section for ways you can get involved!

I want to help True the Vote and Get involved:

Thank you for reaching out to True the Vote about volunteering. We have a few options for you to get started:

1. Sign up for IV3 at iv3.us. We haven't expanded to all states, yet, but we will be adding more as soon as possible so make sure you are on the list! If IV3 isn't active in your state, you can still get involved in voter roll maintenance as nearly every state provides a way for citizens to review voter rolls and submit records to their local election administrators for review.

2. Contact your local political party, elected officials, and Secretary of State about how to work the polls. We need poll workers and poll watchers everywhere.

3. We have to get rid of drop boxes. They are not secure and elected officials have proven that they aren't willing to take on properly securing them. Contact your state and local representatives, your board of elections, and members of Congress to advocate for the removal of drop boxes, and enforceable standards for securing drop boxes until they are removed. Also contact your local law enforcement to make them aware of this issue if they are not already and encourage them to take the necessary steps to be prepared.

4. File an official report through the Election Integrity Tip tool on our website. If you've witnessed election fraud, manipulation, or illegal action, we want to hear from you. Please visit TTV Tip Line to file your report.

We are so thrilled that you are ready to get started securing liberty and ensuring everyone has access to free and fair elections.

matted, compressed, and organized for easier access. This is a priority for us, but it will take time. We appreciate your patience while we prepare and we share your excitement for what comes next!

If research isn't your thing, that's a-ok. This is just step one. There's a lot more work to be done.

The political class responded by playing musical chairs within the Cabinet of Ministers, while demonstrators occupied the area surrounding the Presidential Secretariat. The space that Rajapaksa had set aside as an "agitation area" – a move heavily criticized for limiting people's freedom of assembly – was renamed "GotaGoGama" ("Gota Go Village"). The GGG became the home of the Aragalaya (struggle) against the government, which has now raided the site and arrested protest leaders.

The Aragalaya has been unusual in that it welcomed Sri Lankans from all ethnic backgrounds. In April, protesters outside the Presidential Secretariat included activists from the Muslim community – a direct rejection of the chauvinist sentiment Gotabaya had stoked. Demonstrators also cooked a mixture of water and rice (kanji) to commemorate Tamil civilians who died during the last stages of the war, when indiscriminate shelling made it impossible for them to secure other food.

The Aragalaya thus became a place where people lived out the alternative to the Rajapaksa brand of politics. The protesters celebrated unity amid diversity, demonstrating that hope comes not from leaders but from the power of people. But does this solidarity reflect a mere marriage of convenience? Just two and a half years ago, many of the current anti-government protesters endorsed the Rajapaksas' brand of majoritarian politics. Today, they complain that Par-



liament is full of cheats and liars. Yet it is they who voted for the charlatans in

up at protests are lambasted. The military and the police, once praised for their service, are now seen as vehicles of state repression, and major media organizations have been condemned for whipping up anti-minority sentiment.

The question now is what will fill the vacuum. Sri Lankans have a rare opportunity to build a new identity based on this struggle for dignity. After being tear-gassed and battered by the police, Sinhalese protesters have caught a glimpse of the violence and mistreatment that Tamils have suffered. After watching their businesses collapse from lack of electricity, they now have a sense of what Muslims feel when their businesses are torched by angry mobs. And after feeling the effects of sharply rising inflation, all households now recognize that plantation workers cannot live on \$3 per day.

In each case, the Sinhala-Buddhist majority has been given a window onto the decades of deprivation suffered by minorities. Sinhala Buddhists are connecting with their inner Tamils and Muslims. But only by building on this shared trauma can Sri Lankans transform resentment against the Rajapaksas into a new social contract. By renegotiating our communal bonds and relationships, we can construct a new collective identity. That means rejecting majoritarianism and corruption, and embracing our shared struggle for a free and prosperous future.

The institutions that underwrote Gotabaya's power have now lost credibility. Businesses and others who aligned with the Rajapaksas are being shamed on social media, and any elite Buddhist clergy dare to show

free and fair elections.

The Rajapaksas were given a mandate despite their well-known record of corruption, authoritarianism, and violence. The protests began not when the family stole public funds or trampled on minority rights, but when Sinhalese were called "extremists and terrorists" just for demanding food.

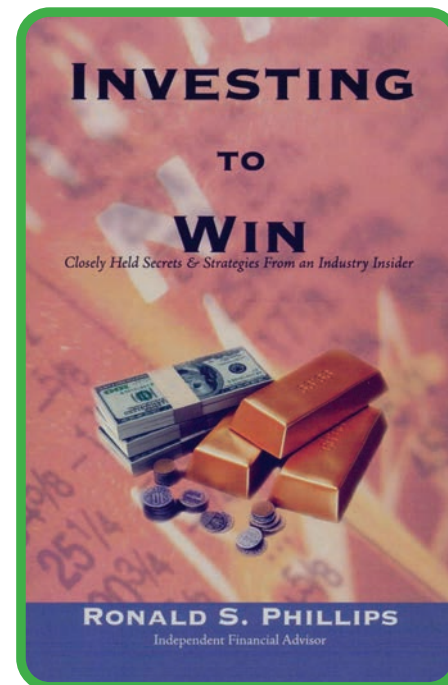

There is more information on accumulating wealth available today than at any other time in history. Again, the US Census sheds some light on wealth accumulation. They found out that the top twenty percent of income earners and the top 5% of wealth gatherers have many habits in common:

- 42.6% own stocks and mutual funds
- 17.5% own their own business or professional practice
- 48.3% invest into an IRA

Those are very simple things that almost any of us can do. It does not take much effort to open an IRA account with investment funds or stocks in it. Could the Earnings Yield Be the Best Single Measure of Stock Value?

I think it definitely could be! I consider it to be the true measure of how you, as a stockholder, are actually benefiting from the company you invested in. You may not actually receive all of the net earnings in cash, but the company can buy back shares with net income, pay you cash dividends, AND/OR reinvest into the growing enterprise. But, first of all, what is an “earnings yield”? It is the opposite of the P/E ratio. It is essentially the E/P ratio. You divide a companies’ total earnings by the total market price of the stock.

For example, if the company you are looking at has annual earnings of \$20 million and a market value of \$200 million, then the earnings yield would be .10 (expressed as a percentage that would be 10%). So for every dollar you are investing into the company, it is earning for you ten cents, or ten percent of a dollar.

If a wonderful and popular company that everyone adored was making \$1 billion dollars every year in net income that looks very good. But if that same business was valued on the stock market for \$100 billion would

the earnings yield be to low? The earnings yield would be a paltry one percent! So for every dollar YOU INVEST INTO THAT STOCK the company is actually only producing one penny in net income for you, the shareholder and part-owner.

The 3-Step, No-Brainer Mutual Fund Strategy

This is a tactic that is very simple and can be used as a stand-alone approach. It is very simple and easy to manage. If this is your only investment it can pay off handsomely for you if allowed to work as described.

STEP ONE: Invest in a Balanced Mutual Fund or Asset Allocation Fund

STEP TWO: Dollar-Cost Average into the Fund & Invest More as it Drops in Value

As you learned earlier, you will accumulate more shares or less-expensive shares with the DCA strategy as the price of the shares move in value. Why fifteen years? According to Morningstar Direct, from the years 1926-2014, you would have had a 99.8% chance of profit if you had invested in stocks and held for fifteen or more years. Yes, you read that correctly; you would have been virtually ASSURED a positive return.

What Is The Difference Between a Global and an International Mutual Fund?

This is an important question. I talk to people a lot that think the two are the same. And by the name they do sound just alike. But there is a big difference, especially when you are trying to properly diversify your assets. In a nutshell, when you see the name global in the mutual fund name or description, those funds will invest in international AND American (domestic) stocks. The international funds should have NO domestic shares.

So you might think The Global ABC Fund is investing all of your money out of the country. But they could have fifty percent of the assets in large-capitalization

US companies. So are you really as diversified as you thought by looking at the name?

On the flip side, if you invested in The International ABC Fund, then 100% of your money should be in foreign shares. Then you can rest assured that you have fully diversified OUTSIDE of the US. Then you can also invest other moneys into domestic funds or shares.

What is GARP Stock Investing?

GARP is an acronym for Growth At a Reasonable Price. As you can guess this approach simply combines both growth and value investing. With this method, you are looking at growth companies selling in the market at value prices. A very famous and successful GARP investor was Peter Lynch, for example.

What Is a REIT?

A REIT is a real estate investment trust. It is a company that buys, manages and sometimes sells individual pieces of real estate. Usually, they are buying the properties, holding for possible appreciation and collecting a cash flow from the underlying real estate. By law...
