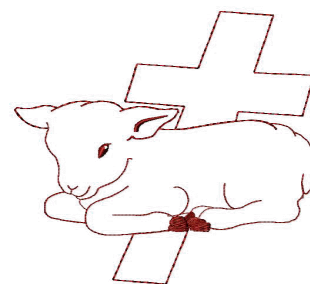

From the Pastor's Desk

As Jesus looks at you, He gazes at you as He gazed at the crowds long ago. As He does, the same depths of mercy and compassion are evoked within His Sacred Heart. Sometimes, when we think of God, we allow ourselves to have inaccurate perceptions of Who He is and how He sees us. If you do not regularly see the compassionate Heart of Jesus, then ponder this passage and know that His Heart of love for you is the same as it was for the crowds.

As you look at your own life, your struggles, your spiritual needs and your desire to grow in faith, how has God fed you? Through whom has He spoken to you? This shepherding will take place by your participation in the Mass, through the Sacrament of Confession, through holy preaching, through the written word, through the inspired witness of another, and in many other ways.

Reflect, today, upon the image of Jesus gazing at you with love and choosing to send His ministers to you in His name and with His authority. Pay special attention to how God has been speaking to you recently. If it is through a particular book, keep reading it. If it is through a certain preacher of the Gospel, keep listening. If it is through a certain conversation with a friend, spouse or loved one, keep talking. God loves you, has a Heart full of compassion for you, and will continue to reach out to you in many different ways, especially by sending others to you in His name.

Cuando Jesús te mira, te mira como miró a las multitudes hace mucho tiempo. Al hacerlo, las mismas profundidades de misericordia y compasión son evocadas dentro de Su Sagrado Corazón. A veces, cuando pensamos en Dios, nos permitimos tener percepciones inexactas de Quién es Él y cómo nos ve. Si no ves regularmente el Corazón compasivo de Jesús, entonces medita en este pasaje y debes saber que Su Corazón de amor por ti es el mismo que fue por las multitudes.

Al mirar tu propia vida, tus luchas, tus necesidades espirituales y tu deseo de crecer en la fe, ¿cómo te ha alimentado Dios? ¿A través de quién os ha hablado? Este pastoreo se llevará a cabo por su participación en la Misa, a través del Sacramento de la Confesión, a través de la predicación santa, a través de la palabra escrita, a través del testimonio inspirado de otro, y de muchas otras maneras.

Reflexiona, hoy, sobre la imagen de Jesús mirándote con amor y eligiendo enviarte a Sus ministros en Su nombre y con Su autoridad. Presta especial atención a cómo Dios te ha estado hablando recientemente. Si es a través de un libro en particular, sigue leyéndolo. Si es a través de cierto predicador del Evangelio, sigue escuchando. Si es a través de cierta conversación con un amigo, cónyuge o ser querido, siga hablando. Dios te ama, tiene un Corazón lleno de compasión por ti y continuará acercándose a ti de muchas maneras diferentes, especialmente enviándote a otros en Su nombre.

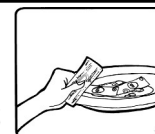

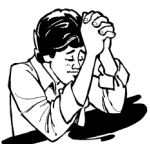
