2025-26 ASL Withdrawal Policy

Local Racing Squad:

All swimmers who wish to withdraw from a current Local Racing Squad session, or who have preregistered for a future Local Racing Squad session they do not intend to participate in, should notify ASL as soon as possible by completing the ASL Withdrawal Form at:

https://forms.gle/UicXhAxSDuJmXLTNA

This notification will facilitate ASL opening the vacated roster spot to a swimmer on the waiting list.

Note: As stated in the ASL Billing Policy and Local Racing Squad Information documents, Local Racing Squad Session Dues already paid to ASL are **non-refundable**.

ASL Travel Squad:

All swimmers who wish to withdraw from the ASLTravel Squad must notify ASL as soon as possible by completing the ASL Withdrawal Form at:

https://forms.gle/UicXhAxSDuJmXLTNA

Account suspension will take effect on the date specified by the account holder on the Withdrawal Form (typically the last day of the current month).

ASL Travel Squad athletes making Membership Dues Installment payments must submit the ASL Withdrawal Form by 12PM on the 28th of the current month to avoid incurring the next Installment payment on the 1st of the following month.

For example, if you intend for your swimmer's last day of participation to be November 30th, you must complete the Withdrawal Form (which is timestamped at completion) by 12PM on November 28th. This will allow adequate time for the Membership Administrator to suspend the account before Captyn processes the next Installment on the 1st of the month. Failure to notify the team of your intent to suspend your account by the deadline will result in the swimmer being billed for the following month, even if they choose not to participate in team activities.

Note: As stated in the ASL Billing Policy and ASL Travel Squad Information documents, all ASL Travel Squad Membership Dues ("One-Time" and Installments) already paid to ASL are **non-refundable**.
